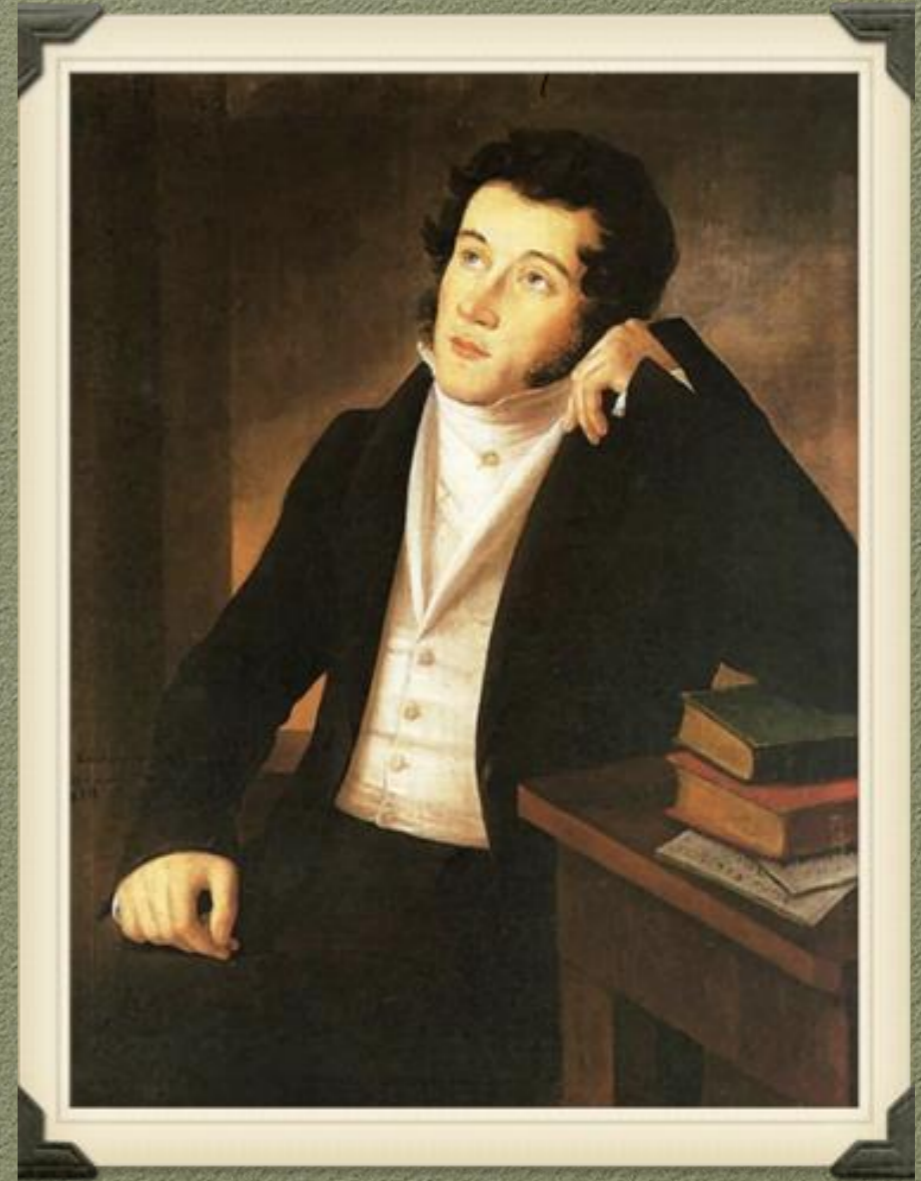

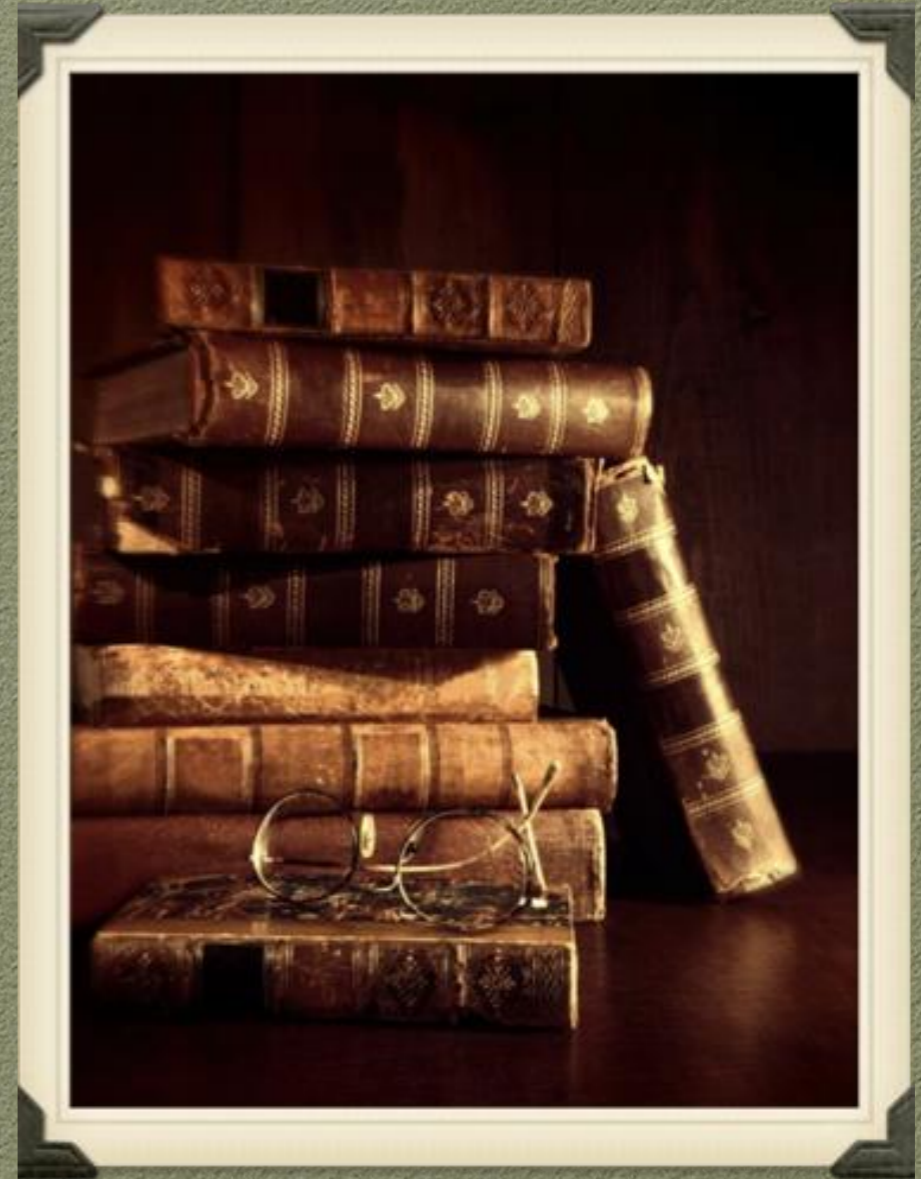


Adam Mickiewicz was born on 24th December 1798 and he died on 26th November 1855. His work involved writing, teaching and he was a professor of literature.

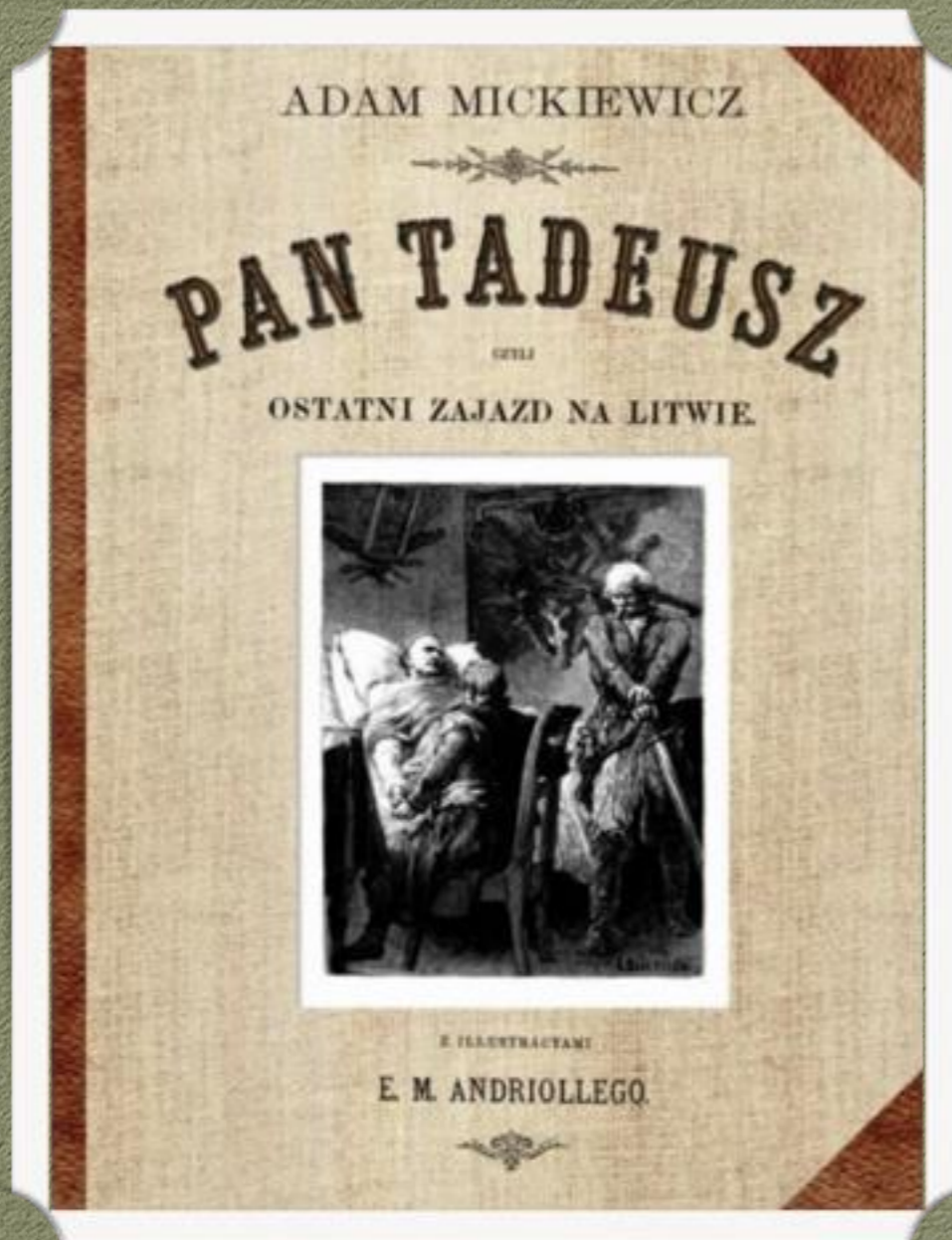
- He is regarded as a national poet in Poland, Lithuania and Belarus.

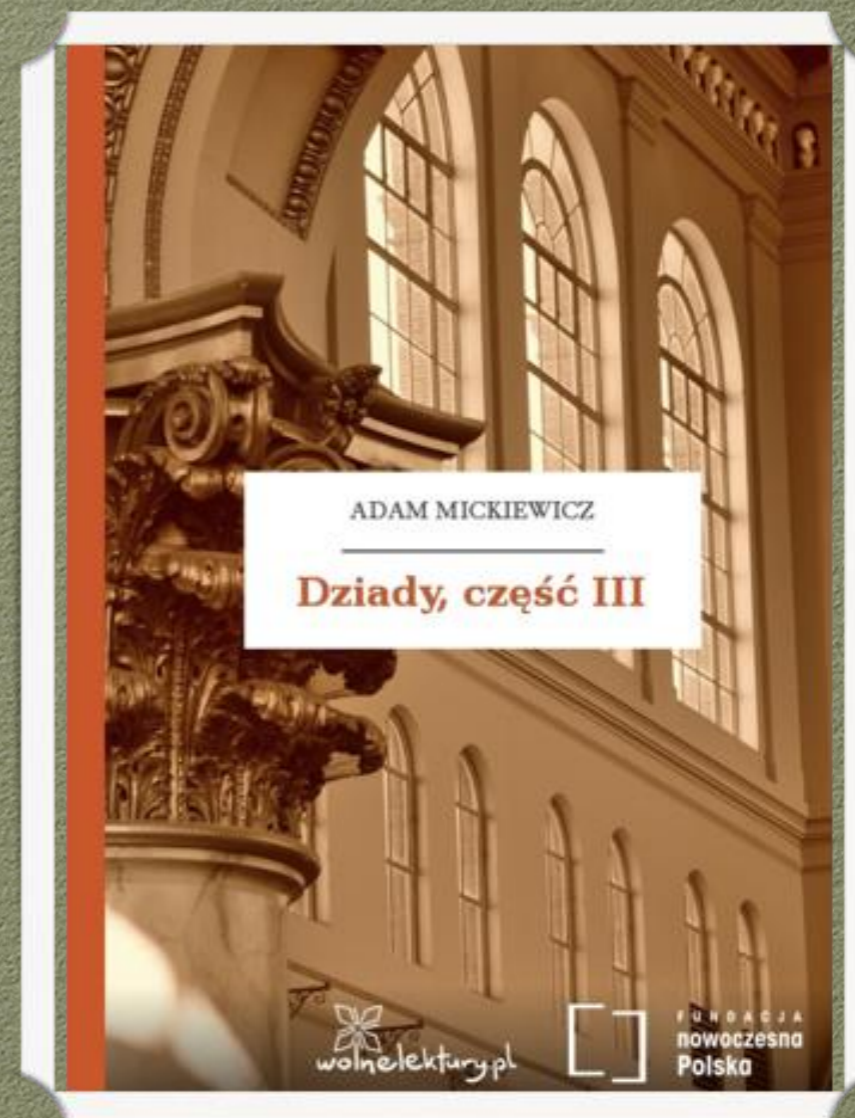


*Oh Lithuania, native land, thou

for thee*

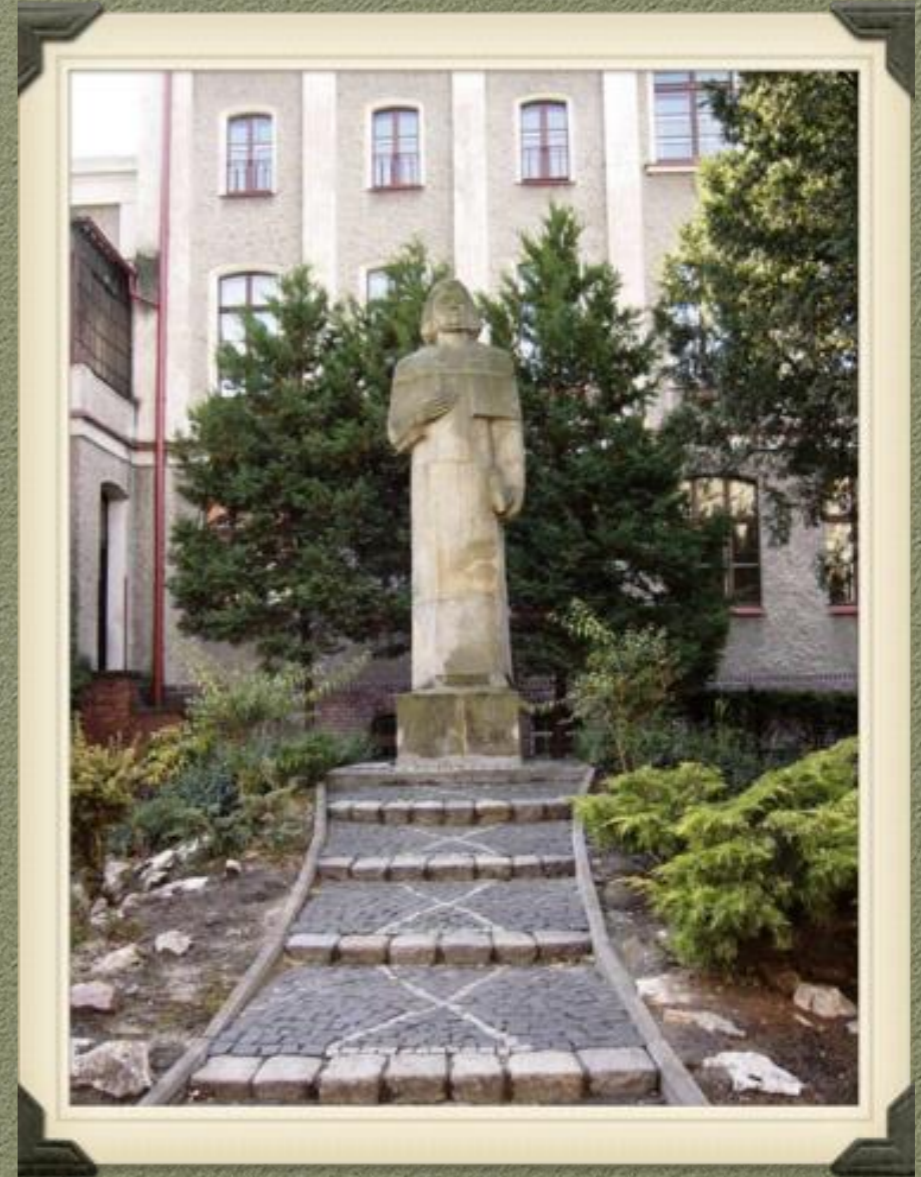


„Dziady”
