

## Lesson Plan

Form: 8<sup>th</sup>

Subject: Literature

Teacher: Sophia Papadopoulou

Topic of the lesson:

List of required material: an extract from Antoine de Saint-Exupery's, "The Little Prince", multimedia.

Process of the lesson: teaching and learning activities.

The methods used during the lesson were dialogue, group collaboration and heuristic conversation.

At the beginning of the lesson the students were separated into groups and studied an extract from "The Little Prince", which was related to the fox and the rose and they compare/contrast this with the story of little Andreas. They searched to find common elements between the symbolisms of the two.

Thereafter, the students were asked to look back on their literature sources to find acts of heroism and altruism from other children who despite their age of innocence realized early on the meaning of life.

At the end of the lesson the students drew a hero who they admired for a specific reason, for an altruistic act and they briefly presented it.
