TRAIN ACCIDENT

On 23 July, 2013 a high-speed train derailed, killing 79 people and injuring around 140 others. The Alvia train was travelling from Madrid to Ferrol when it derailed at high speed on a curve 4 miles outside of the railway station at Santiago de Compostela, Spain. It was Spain's worst train accident in 40 years.
