Worksheet

WRITING AN ARTICLE

An essential ingredient of writing a successful article is structuring your ideas strongly. Try using the following as a model for writing an article about a topic of your choice.

INTRODUCTION

Think of a **striking opening sentence** which addresses the reader (make sure you know who your readers are going to be) and **gets them interested** in your topic.

FIRST PARAGRAPH

Present a strong argument for your case and support it with at least TWO sentences providing evidence or elaboration. Then close the paragraph with a link to the next paragraph.

SECOND AND THIRD PARAGRAPHS

Make your next points at the beginning of the paragraph, ensuring that you support them with evidence, or develop your ideas as fully as you can.

FOURTH PARAGRAPH

FIFTH PARAGRAPH

Wind up with **your strongest point**, and make sure you sound extremely confident in your argument. You might want to address the readers again here.

CONCLUSION

Definitely **address your reader** here, and state your point **simply and powerfully**. You should not have any evidence in this paragraph or further develop your point.

OTHER INGREDIENTS

Think about using the passive voice, humour, emotive language, rhetorical questions, and alliteration
