## VISIT TO EL HIERRO

### **GORONA DEL VIENTO**

The **Gorona del Viento** (GdV) plant on the Canary Island of El Hierro is a flagship project designed ultimately to provide the island with 100% renewable electricity and to demonstrate that hybrid wind/pumped hydro systems can be used to generate 100% renewable electricity in other parts of the world. GdV comprises a wind park with 11.5 MW capacity and a pumped hydro storage plant with 11.3MW capacity, installed at a total cost of €84 million.

# **MIRADOR DE LA PEÑA**

The lookout point was the design of the Lanzarote artist of world fame, Cesar Manrique, and has been declared Cultural heritage property by the Autonomous Government of the Canary Islands. From here, there are magnificent views over the Valle del Golfo. The restaurant offers the best in local food with all of the flavours and aromas of the island together with quality presentation of international cuisine.

# (\*) SUGGESTED OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES and VISITS

**The Palmetum** of Santa Cruz de Tenerife (Web: <a href="www.palmetumtenerife.es">www.palmetumtenerife.es</a>) is a 12-hectare botanical garden that specialises in palm trees. This project is unique in the world. It has transformed a municipal rubbish dump into a recreational space for plant lovers, bursting with spectacular plant life brought here through partnerships with institutions from all over the world.

The Santa Cruz Palmetum Gardens are home to the greatest collection of palms in Europe, thought to be the largest botanical collection of tropical island palms in the world.

### FROM RUBBISH DUMP TO GARDEN. AN EXAMPLE OF SUSTAINABILITY

The Palmetum is located on the south coast of the city, on land claimed from the sea. Its name, "The Lazaretto", bears testimony to the fact that people with contagious diseases were originally housed here; later it was home to various industrial facilities. The hill, with a surface area of 12 hectares and a height of 40m, was formed by the disposal of Santa Cruz's municipal waste up until 1983, when it was closed.

OPENING HOURS: From 10:00 am to 6:00 pm (gates close at 5:00 pm)

**The Parque Marítimo** (Seaside park) **César Manrique** (Web: <a href="www.parquemaritimosantacruz.es">www.parquemaritimosantacruz.es</a>) is a complex of 22,000 m² located on the south coast of the Tenerife capital, Santa Cruz de Tenerife, with unbeatable views of the Tenerife Auditorium, designed by Santiago Calatrava, the Palmetum botanical garden and the sea. Easily accessible by car and public transport, this leisure center has a large parking area. In it, the black of the volcanic stone contrasts with the blue of the crystal clear waters and the green of the palm trees and the flowers that adorn the space.

In addition to its 3 saltwater swimming pools, it has restaurant services, shops, changing rooms, playrooms, showers and a gym, as well as hammock and umbrella rental services, making it an ideal place for tourist, family, leisure and rest activities.

**Las Teresitas Beach** (Web: <u>playadelasteresitas.es/en</u>) is the most emblematic one in Santa Cruz de Tenerife. Located in the town of San Andrés, this golden sandy beach is alive with palm trees and is a very popular spot among residents of Santa Cruz.

Its waters are calm thanks to the breakwaters that have been built to calm the waves, making it an ideal option for a family day out and a walk along the shore.

You will find all the amenities right on the beach (showers, lifeguards, disabled access), and you will also be able to combine a refreshing dip with a snack at the beach bars.

### **Tenerife Auditorium Guided Tour**

Visitors can explore the building through the "Discover the Hidden Corners" scheme. You can book your visit by telephone on (+34)922 568 625, or by sending an e-mail to visitas@auditoriodetenerife.com. **Guided tours take** place at 12.30 pm from Monday to Saturday. Advance booking is not compulsory, but is recommended.

## **TEA** - Tenerife Arts Centre (Web: <a href="http://www.teatenerife.es/">http://www.teatenerife.es/</a>)

A must-see cultural centre featuring exhibition halls, a library, a cinema, cultural activities, and more. The architects Jacques Herzog, Pierre de Meuron and Virgilio Gutiérrez, designed the 20,600 square metres of the complex. The TEA is located in the renovated old quarter of Santa Cruz de Tenerife, between la Recova market and la Concepción Church, next to the Museum of Nature and Mankind. This cultural space houses organizations such as the Óscar Domínguez Institute, the Tenerife Photography Centre, and the Island Network Library. Moreover, the centre has various common areas including an auditorium, shop, cafe, and semi-covered plaza.
