

## Our « TAP-TAP »

### Material :



### For one instrument you need:

- °A round box (like cardboard cheese box)
- °Plastic threads (about 30cm per instruments which you will cut into 2 pieces of 15 cm each)
- °Wooden beads
- °Wooden stick
- °Paint
- ° Strong glue

### Preparation :

1: You paint the cheese box  
(it is better if you have  
peeled off the paper before)

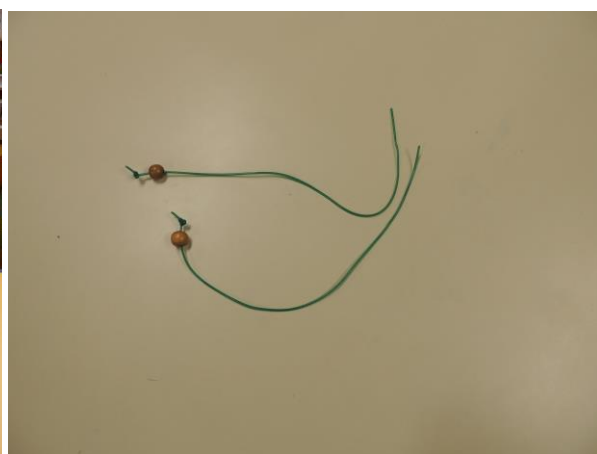
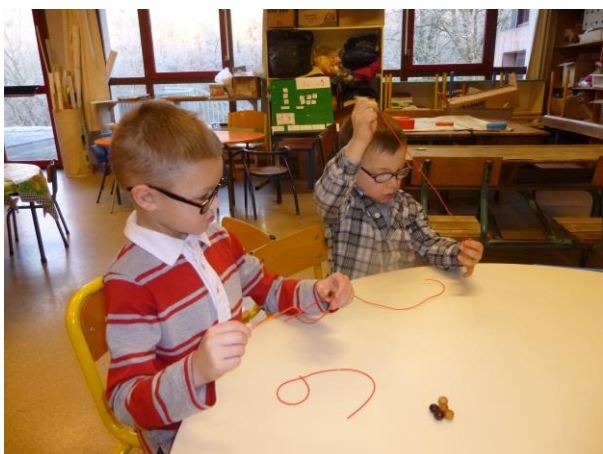


You can choose different  
colors for each sides or  
change colors...

2: You choose your plastic threads  
(2 per instrument) while  
boxes are drying...

You make a knot on one end  
of the thread.

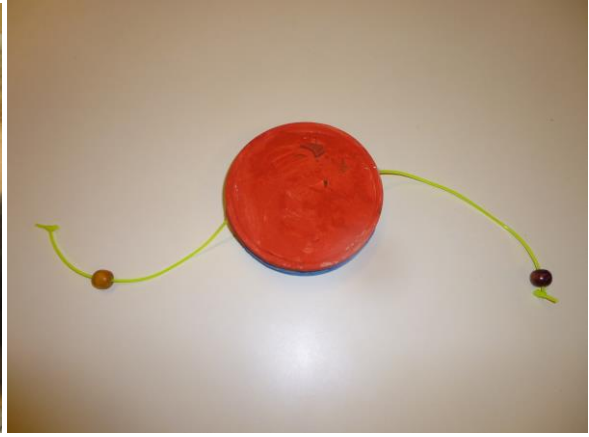
And you string the bead..



3: you make a little hole on  
each side of the box.  
And you string the thread in  
the little hole. And you make  
another knot inside the box.





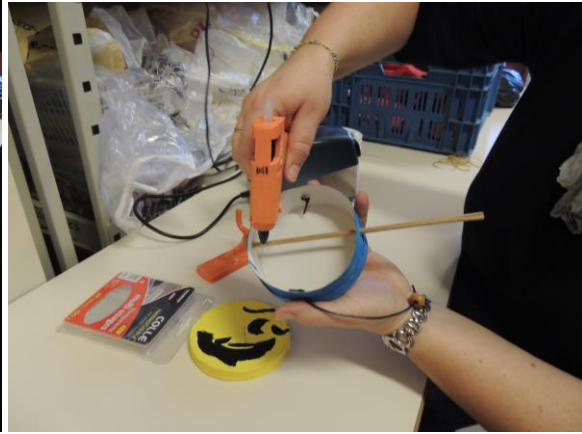


4: to make it look even nicer, we have added a drawing on each side using a stencil, and glittering paint...



Our school helper had done a hole on the bottom of the box; she has used strong glue to stick the wooden stick...





Finally, you glue the two sides of the boxes together and it's time to play !!
