

Some of the IT-tools that we got to know during our meeting in Manlleu inspired some of the Belgian teachers to incorporate similar things in their own lessons.



Dutch:


The pupils had to write a story and they were all published on a map. Each story took place in a city somewhere around the world. When you click on an icon, you can read the story.



The pupils could read each other's stories as well. This motivated them to do their best for this assignment.



History:
