FOLLOW THE STEPS

- 1) Agree on the melody/ tune
 - a. Famous song
 - b. Easy song for children
 - c. One you know well
- 2) Select a topic
 - a. Reduce, Reuse, Recycle
 - b. You have to give a message
- 3) Brainstorm your ideas (any language)
- 4) Order these ideas
 - a. All in English
- 5) Put them in verses.
 - a. They rhyme in lines of two, four or eight.
 - b. A common rhyme scheme is ABAB, CDCD, Chorus: EEFF
- 6) Write a chorus that you can repeat
- 7) A good order could be
 - o Verse
 - o Chorus
 - o Verse
