

RULES

To begin with, each player selects a token. One player becomes the banker who distributes assets from the bank to the players. Each player receives two 500€, two 200€, four 100€, three 50€, five 20€, two 10€ and four 5€.

On a player's turn he or she must roll the dice and move his or her token forward the number of spaces as rolled on the dice.

- If a player lands on an unwanted museum he or she may buy it for the price listed on that property space.
- If a player lands on a museum owned by another player he or she pays rent to that person as specified on the museum's deed. It's the museum owner's responsibility to demand rent.
- If a player lands on a quiz or ?, the player takes a card from the top of the pack and performs the instruction given on the card.
- If a player lands on the „**CLOSED**” space, he or she must wait one turn.
- If a player lands on or passes „**START**” space in the course of his or her turn, he or she receives 200€ from the bank.
- If a player lands on „**BACKER**” space in the course of his or her turn, he or she receives 50€ from the bank.
- If a player lands on „**AUCTION**” space in the course of his or her turn, he or she may buy or sell museums and artefacts.
- A player who buys „**SOUVENIR SHOP**” gets 30€ from each player who lands on „**SOUVENIR SHOP**” space.
- If a player doesn't have sufficient funds to pay off a rent or fee, he or she may take a loan from the bank by mortgaging one or more museums, sell artefacts back to the bank for half the purchase price or sell museum deeds to other players in the game.
- Once a player owns all museums of a country group, the rent is now doubled.
- The player may buy up to 3 artefacts which raise the rent that must be paid when other players land on the museum.
