Tallinn Old Town

Russian-Livonian war took place in the 16th century.



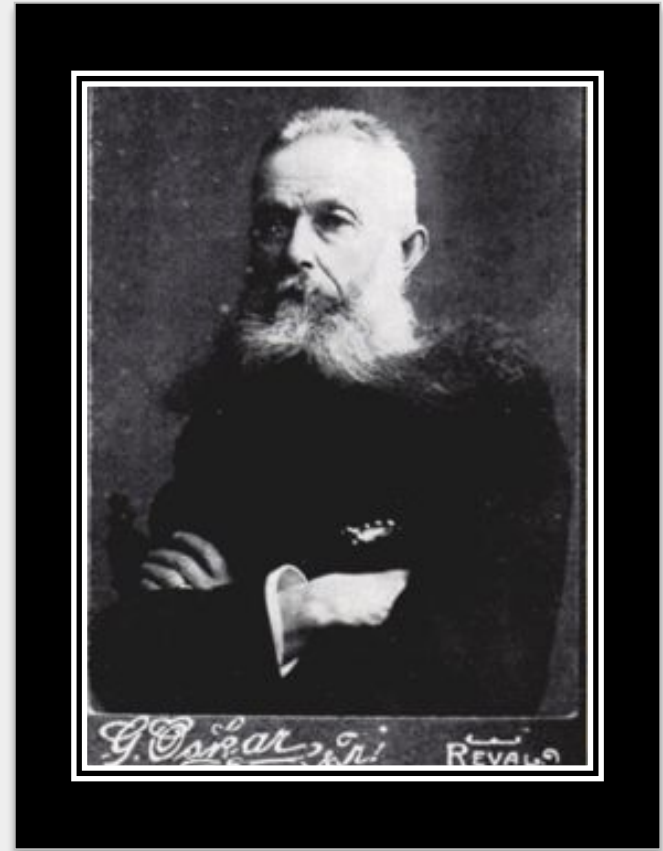
German occupation in Estonia

The 18th century was a period in Estonian history, part of Estonia's early modern and modern times.



Great Northern War

The land master of the Livonian Order was the highest local leader of the Livonian branch of the German Order (Livonian Order) in 1237–1562.
