## Education

- Our collège Jean Monnet is a free public middle-school.
- Pupils are aged 11-15.
- Teachers follow the French national curriculum.
- There are 4 years of learning from the equivalent of 7th grade to 10th grade (6ème à 3ème).



# Specific learning

- Everyone learn German and English as foreign languages and cultures. Some pupils follow the bilingual curriculum, which means that they learn maths and biology in German.
- Our school library is organised like a learning centre and includes an Art and Culture Place (LAC Lieu d'Art et de Culture) which welcomes many exhibitions and events every year. Pupils also enjoy playing the piano in the school library.
- There is an inclusive section for disabled children (ULIS), with about 10 to 15 pupils.


# Special rooms



- Pupils attend some lessons in specific places:
  - A computer room with 18 computers.
  - Four science laboratories, for making experiments in biology, physics and chemistry.
  - A music and an art classrooms.
  - A sport hall, for learning to go beyond one's limits and for a cheering crowd at pupils vs teachers matches.

# Etwinning and Erasmus +

- We are proud to be involved in the EBE LEARNING CROSSING BORDERS partnership, for eTwinning and Erasmus +.
- There are currently 4 active eTwinning projects for our students.
- There are 16 closed projects on eTwinning for our school, in both German and English target languages.

- Pupils will study the newly released documentary film « Le Liseré Vert ».
- Gilles Weinzaepflen, a local filmmaker, has followed all 4056 border stones dating from the 1870s.

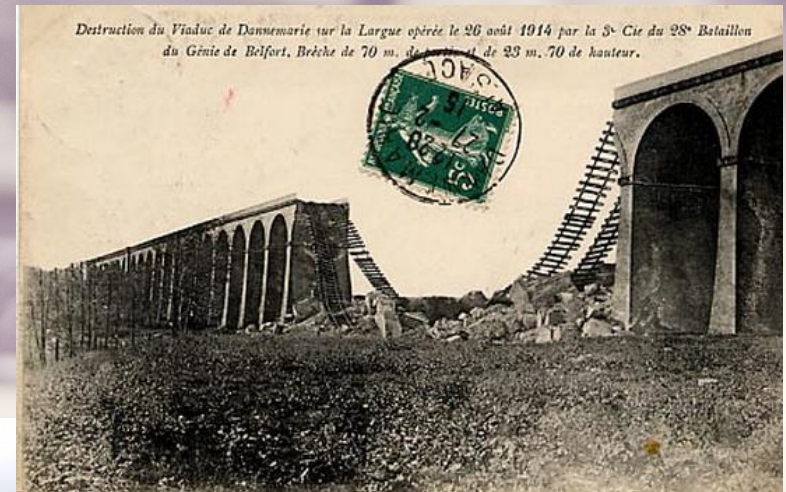


The old border from 1870

# EBE LEARNING CROSSING BORDERS

- From our classrooms, we can often see the TGV on fast speed atop the viaduc which was destroyed during wars and then rebuilt.
- Pupils will follow the old rail trails, on foot or by bike.

- These are not mushrooms, although they have sprouted all around the Alsatian landscape during WWII.
- Pupils will investigate the many bunkers in and around their villages.

- These are the Vauban fortifications in Neuf-Brisach, in Alsace.
- Pupils will take the bus to visit this world heritage site.
