

LOCAL FESTIVALS IN SPAIN

- San Juan is a typical festival in Muskiz, where all the people of the city meets together and they make parade with torches around the city and to finish with all the torches they make a gigant bonfire.
- San Fermin is a traditional festival in Spain exactly in "Pamplona" the most popular event is when the people run with the bulls, most of them they don't agree with killing the bulls in front of people and they are fighting to change it.



LOCAL FESTIVALS IN CZECHIA

- The most known festivals around Zlin are Film festival for children, Masters of rock (about metal and rock music) and Trnkobraní (about alcohol, mostly from plumes)
- We have different traditions like burning the witches (czech tradition, where people burn figurines of witches on wooden tower or bonfire. Some women dress up like witches and wear their hats. People around roast sausages in the fire and some of them also marshmallows.





TRADITIONAL FESTIVALS

• Christmas:

- In both Spain and Czechia, people decorate christmas trees where they later find presents. But the dates are different. Most czechs open presents in evening of 24th of December, but in Spain people do this in morning of 25th of December. In Spain normally we eat seafood and some families eat mutton or chicken, whereas in czechia we eat carp or different fish (or in some families chicken) with potato salad.
- Easter:
 - Most of people in Spain to celebrate the easter holidays they decide to go away their homes to relax and chill for a time but the christian people celebrates the death of Jesus. In Czechia, we have some traditions, that make our Easter different. Men beat women with whips made from wooden twigs and women give them treat like painted eggs for that.
- New Year's Eve/Day:
 - In Spain there's tradition that for last 12 seconds, people eat a grape for each second. Then, the celebration in Spain and Czechia is similar

 we have a party and fire fireworks after midnight. Also in czechia, people make new year's resolutions.
- Halloween:
 - In Spain when you are a child is very usual to dress up and ask in the houses from some candys and when they grow up it is very typical going parties. In czechia we carve scary faces into pumpkins, but it's not common to celebrate halloween more.

DAY PLAN

• <u>Spain:</u>

- In a normal day we usually wake up at 8:00 in the morning

- In the end of the day, we take dinner at 18 and then we just chill watching tv
- Most of people fall asleep just after 22

 Similar in both countries: football is the most popular one, then we have basketball, volleyball, handball, athletics etc.






WEATHER
