# A SHORT BIOGRAPHY OF MARTYNA WOJCIECHOWSKA

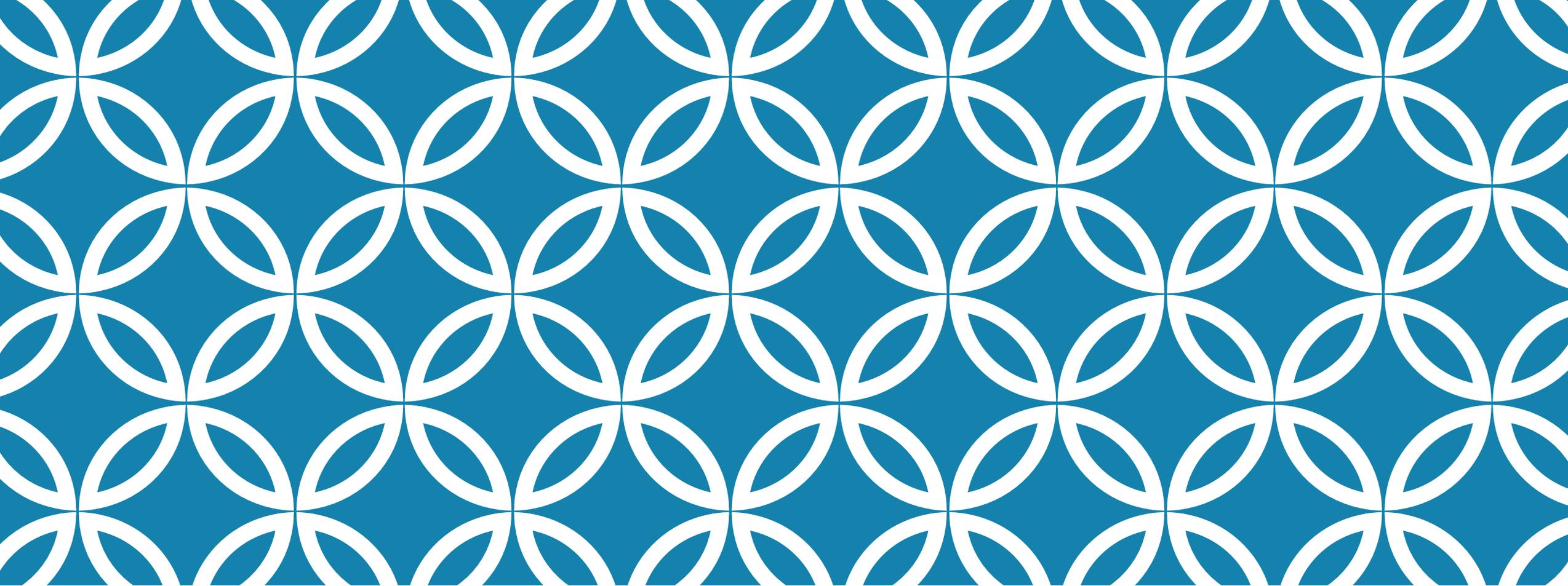


She was born in Warsaw on September 28, 1974. She trained artistic gymnastics. At the age of 19, she made her debut on television as a model. She studied marketing and management, specializing in HR (human resource management).

As a journalist, she first appeared in the magazine „World of Motorcycles“. Later, she also wrote articles for "Auto Moto", "Voyage" and "Playboy". In 2007 she became the chief journalist - editor of the Polish version of the famous "National Geographic" and "National Geographic Traveler", then she was also in the editorial office of the "Kaleidoscope" magazine.

Martyna Wojciechowska ran many programs, but the most famous program was "Woman at the End of the World,,.

.She is the second Polish woman to have won the Crown of the Earth, and the third youngest Poland, conqueror of Mount Everest



# CHARITY WORK



She is an honorary ambassador of WWF Poland. She supported, among others a call to protect Africa's oldest national park, Virunga, from oil drilling (under pressure from global action, Total and Soco pulled out of their plans). She supports the protection of Polish lynxes. She was also involved in the campaign "Don't talk to me bear", which was aimed at spreading knowledge about bears living in Poland.



In 2013, she became a member of the Polish Humanitarian Action. At that time, she joined in helping refugees from Syria



She was involved in the construction of the pediatric hematology clinic "Cape of Hope" in Wrocław . After receiving the title of the Woman of the Year „Your Style" in 2009, presented to her by professor Alicja Chybicka, she also received an invitation to the oncology clinic in Wrocław. On September 7, 2015, she participated in the inauguration of a new clinic in Wrocław, for the construction of which she donated PLN 50,000. She has the geographical coordinates of the clinic tattooed on her arm.

He actively participates in all events and fundraisers for the Cape of Hope. One of the items she auctioned off for the foundation was a figurine of Ganesha, the Hindu god of happiness and prosperity. Ultimately, the figurine was sold for the sum of PLN 230,000.



She supports various social actions. She joined the campaigns against the mutilation of girls and women of the Waris Dirie "Desert Flower" foundation . She also supported a nationwide women's protest, known as the "Black Protest" . In 2016, she became the ambassador of the action of the mineral water producer Żywiec Zdrój "On the side of nature" as part of the National Day on the Side of Nature



In May 2017, she confessed that she is in the process of adopting children from distant corners of the world. One of them is Kabula Nkalango Mensaje, the protagonist of the film *People of Ghosts*, who testified in court that she was in the care of the traveler.
