LATVIA

Children have made posters with important buildings / places of each country of our cooperation.

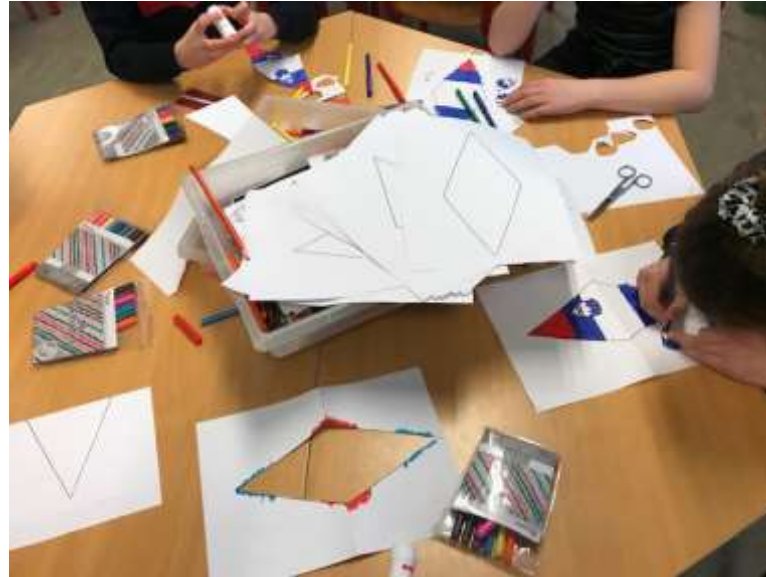


Skype session between group 8 and Poland

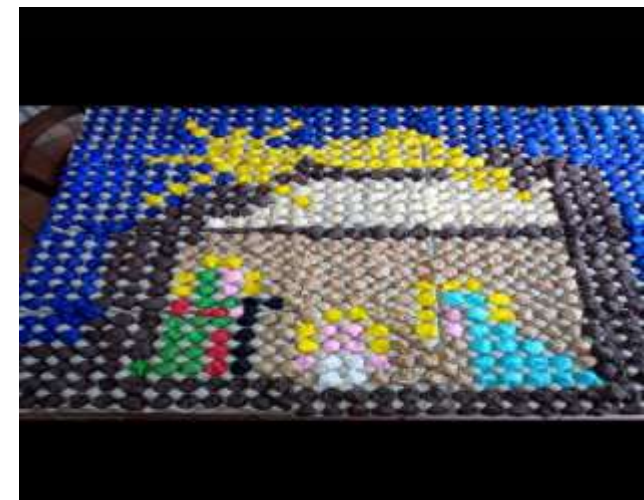
ITALY

In December children prepared a crib with recycled material - coloured paper and heavy paper boxes from eggs



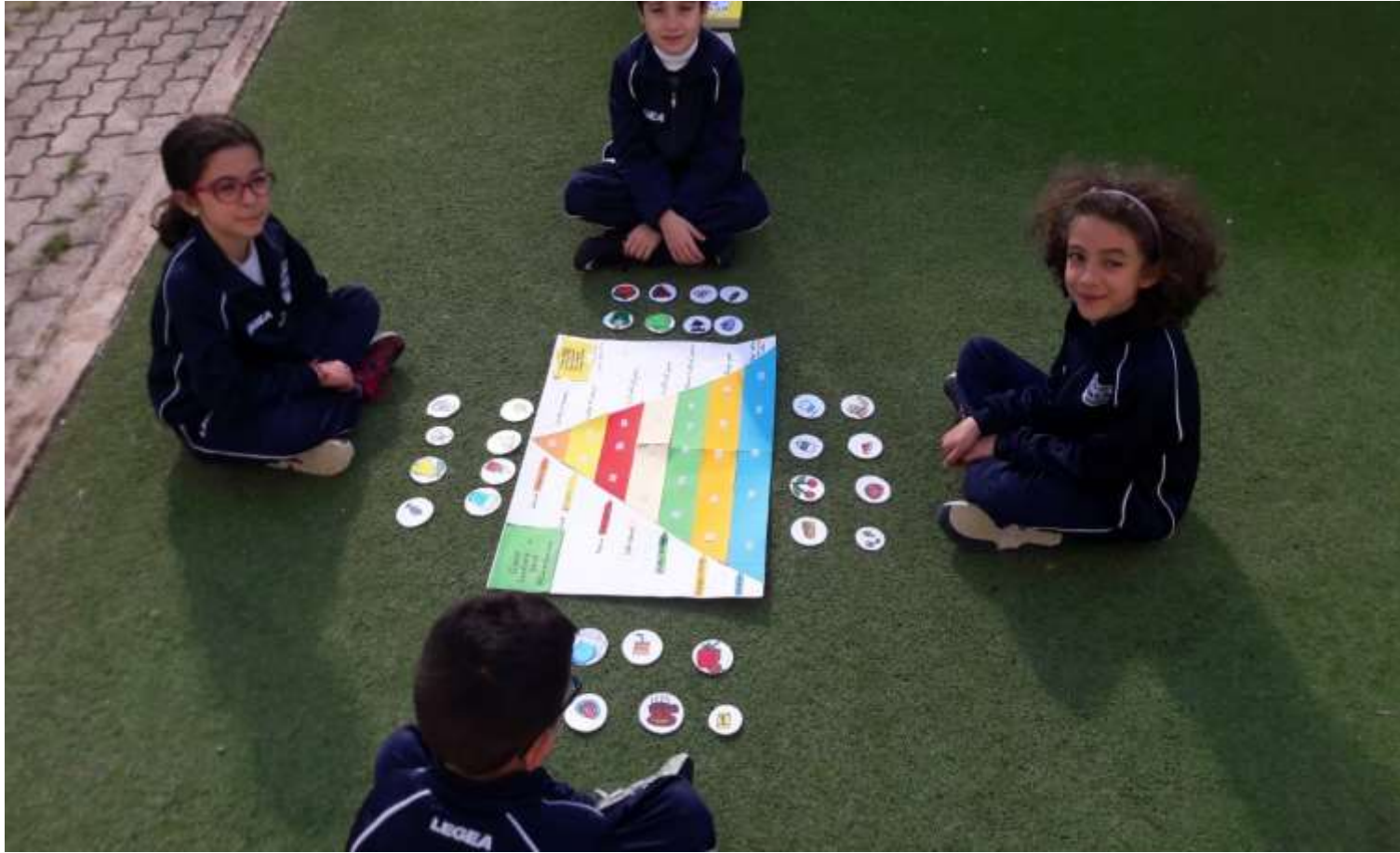


Children create and play games about healthy food and healthy life (eco game plus eco hourglass)
