We first went to Zisa, it was a big, nice castle built during the 12th century by Arab craftsmen. It was used as a summer residence by Norman kings. After that we visited Cappella Palatina or Palace Church, we learned that it was built over an older chapel that is now used as the crypt. The mosaics presented stories of the Bible, more specifically of the Genesis chapter. And then we saw Quattro Canti, officially known as Piazza Vigliena. It is four-sided. Also we got to Piazza Pretoria, also known as the square of Shame, is at the limits of the district of Kalsa, near the corner of Cassaro with Via Maqueda, just a few meters from the Quattro Canti, the exact center of the historic city of Palermo. We also made a stop on Martorana. The church is renowned for its spectacular interior, which is dominated by a series of 12th-century mosaics executed by Byzantine craftsmen. The mosaics show many iconographic and formal similarities to the roughly contemporary programs in the Cappella Palatina. Before leaving Palermo we made a last stop at the Teatro Massimo Vittorio Emanuele, an opera house and opera company located on the Piazza Verdi in Palermo, Sicily. It was dedicated to King Victor Emmanuel II. It is the biggest in Italy, and one of the largest in Europe. At last we visited the beautiful city of Monreale and had a tour around the town.

Monday 12.12.16

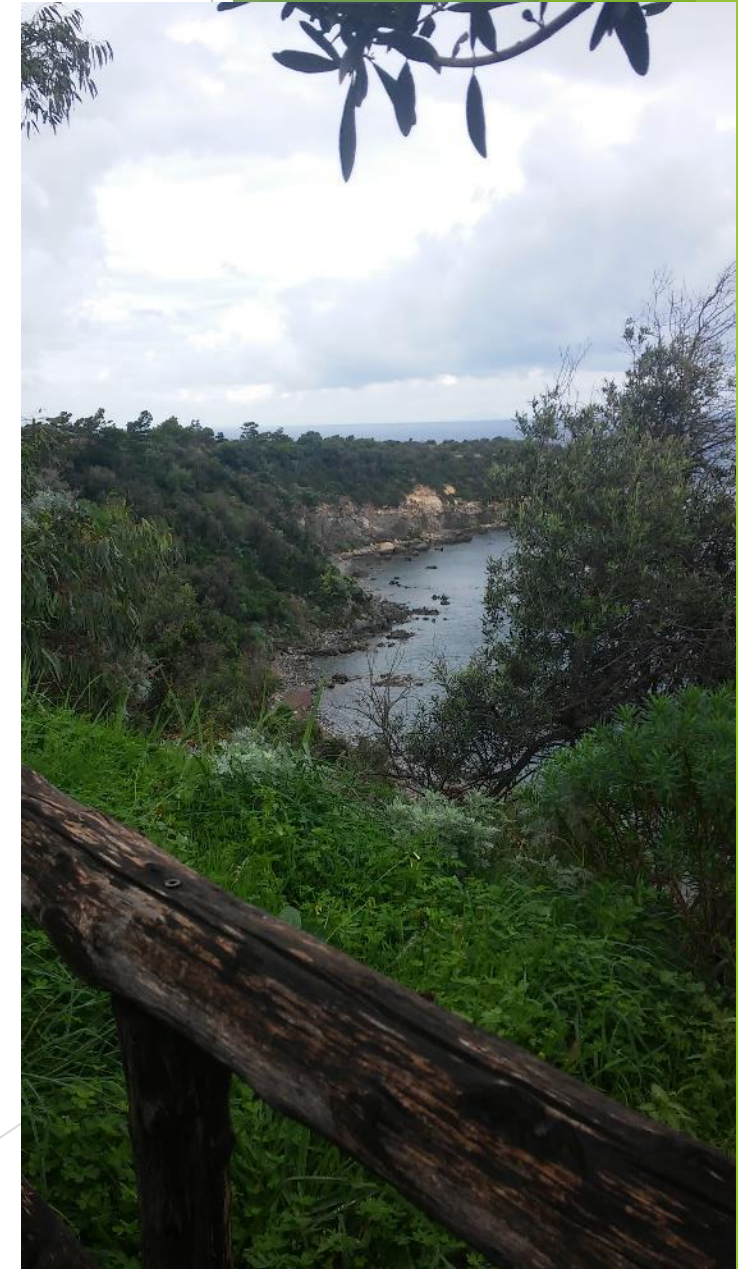
