

**Level:** Primary school

**Age group:** 6/7 years old

**Type of work:** individual

**Preparation:** Copy the task with geometrical figures- one copy for each person.



Students need a glue stick, scissors, felt-tip pens, crayons .

**Method:** The teacher reads out the fairy tale about a square.

### **The fairy tale about a square:**

Once upon a time, behind the mountains and the forests, where the honey rivers flow- there was the beautiful and square kingdom. There were square houses, square flowers bloomed there, square dragonflies flew there and square birds sang there. There was a square castle with 4 towers and a drawbridge, enormous square gates, gold square balconies. In the square room the king with a square crown was sitting on the throne. He was scratching his square head while talking to his nation.

### **The task after reading**

- a) Cut out squares, stick them on the piece of paper creating the square kingdom according to the content of the fairy tale.
- b) You may colour the created kingdom.

You can edit the content of the fairy tale changing names of figures. It can be about rectangles, triangles, circles etc.
