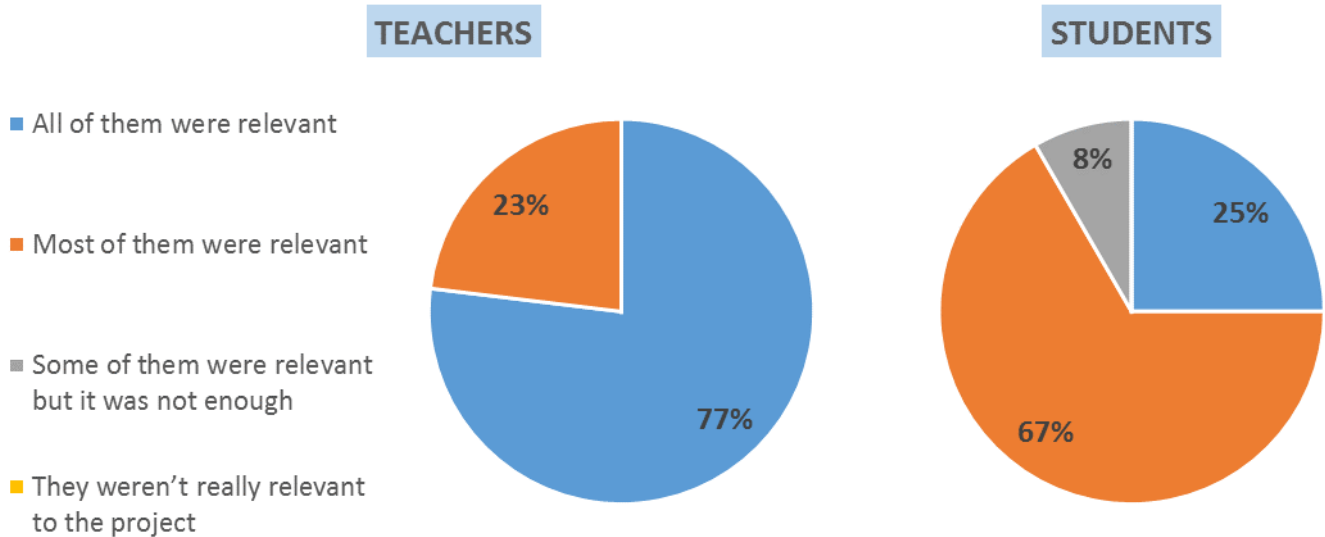


QUESTIONNAIRE FOR TEACHERS (13) AND STUDENTS (36)

Question 1: To what extent do you think the activities provided during this week were relevant to the objectives of the project?

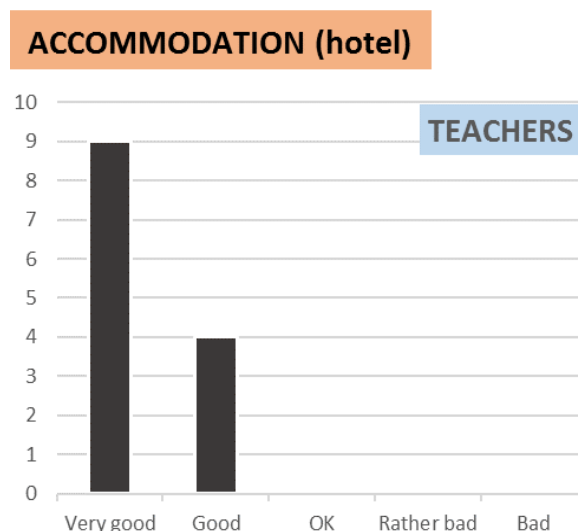

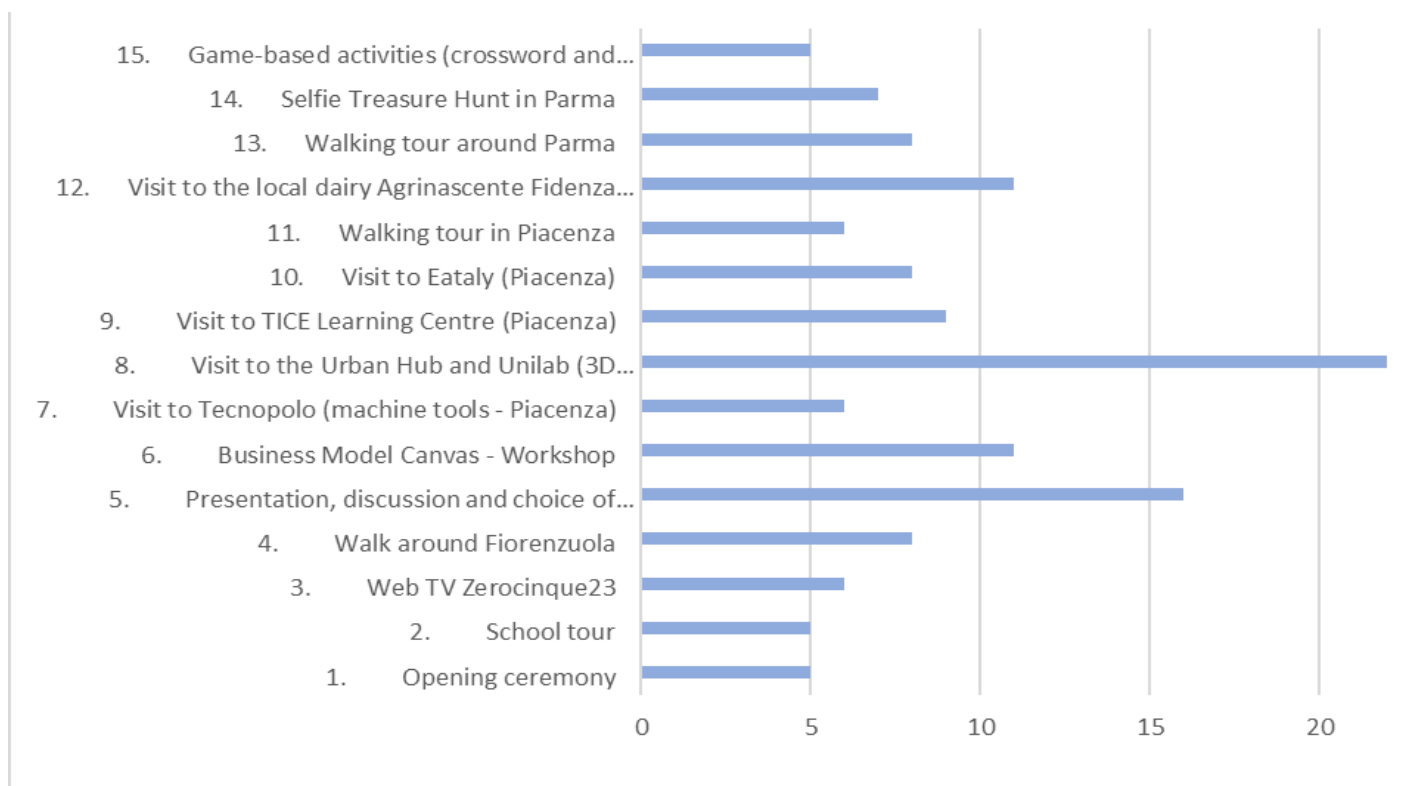


Question 4: Which of these activities in your opinion were the most connected with the idea of the project? Why?
