1. To what extent has the project "Empower Students with Entrepreneurial Skills" responded to the needs of the students in our school grouping?

The implementation of the project has helped our students become more self-confident and motivated. In addition to it, students have become more aware of the importance of promoting their own educational and professional growth on an international level. As a result, more and more students are interested in taking part in a E+ project. After getting their final diploma, some participants have decided to take part in a new E+ project (12-month work experience abroad)

2. In your opinion, how did the project contribute for a positive image of our school?

The project has reported high levels of satisfaction among students, parents and teachers. Our main stakeholders (local public institutions and business companies) have shown great appreciation for the efforts made to foster entrepreneurial skills among learners. School enrolment has been positively affected by the successful implementation of the project.

3. Regarding the disclosure of the project and its activities, was it accurate or do you recommend other forms of disclosure?

Most dissemination activities were accurate and effective. Among the most effective ones I would mention: 1. school website 2. school meetings 3. word of mouth 4. local newspapers.

I don't think the creation of a blog was useful; an FB page would have been more successful among students, teachers and families (sharing posts usually has a 'snowball effect' in terms of dissemination.)

4. Refer to the adequacy of the activities developed during the project.

The activities were usually adequate.

Both students and teachers enjoyed the business visits and workshops. Some conferences/seminars by experts were a bit too challenging for teenagers.
