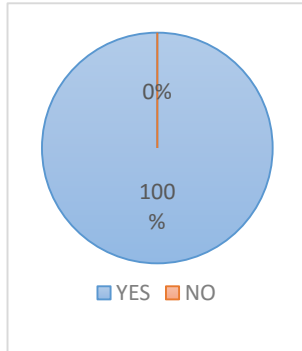
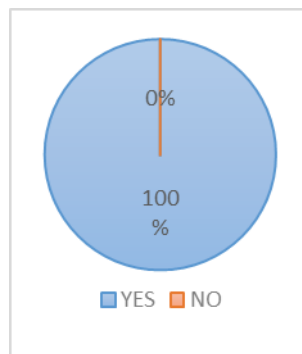

**1. Are you satisfied with the outcomes of the activities of this project?**



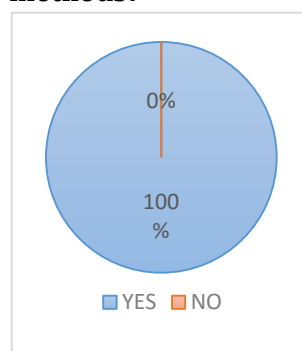
**2. Do you consider that the work carried out had a positive influence on your students' attitudes towards school tasks?**



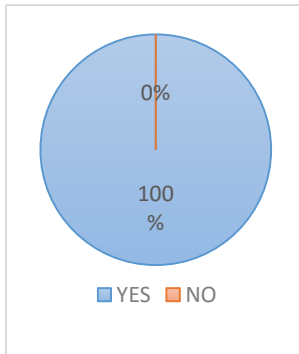
