- Dubrovnik is a Croatian city on the Adriatic Sea in the region of Dalmatia.
- The highlight of Dubrovnik is its 2 kilometre-long walls that surround the city centre, which have been a popular filming location for the fictional King's Landing, the capital of seven kingdoms, in the HBO television series, *Game of Thrones*.
- Robin Hood was filmed there a few weeks ago.



Plitvice lakes National Park







- Plitvice Lakes National Park is one of the oldest national parks in Southeast Europe and the largest national park in Croatia.
- Each year, more than 1 million visitors enjoy the beauty of the lakes.
- The two largest lakes, Prošćansko jezero and Kozjak, cover about 80 percent of the overall water body area.

Zagreb



- Zagreb is the capital and the largest city of Croatia.
- Zagreb has been voted the best European Christmas market destinations twice.
- It is the biggest metropolitan area in Croatia, and the only one with a population of over one million.



Split

- Split is the second-largest city of Croatia and the largest city of the region of Dalmatia.
- Split is traditionally associated with the construction of Diocletian's Palace
- The city was founded several centuries earlier as the Greek colony.
- Ultra music festival is the most popular event for young people in Split.





Zadar

- Zadar is the oldest continuously inhabited city in Croatia.
- The Sea organ is an architectural musical object located on the shore, which plays music by way of sea waves and tubes located underneath a set of large marble steps.



- Krka National Park is a Croatian national park named after the river Krka that makes stunning waterfalls.
- It is famous for its beautiful scenery and untouched nature and cool water during summer time.





Pula

Arena in Pula was built in the 1st century AD during the reign of Emperor Vespasian, at the same time as the magnificent Colosseum in Rome.

It is a place where concerts and theatre plays are held.







National park Kornati

- The Kornati also known as the Stomorski islands is the national park which includes 109 islands
- Kornat is the biggest of the islands with a total area of 32.44 square kilometres.
