Frankfurt is in Germany in the state of Hessen.

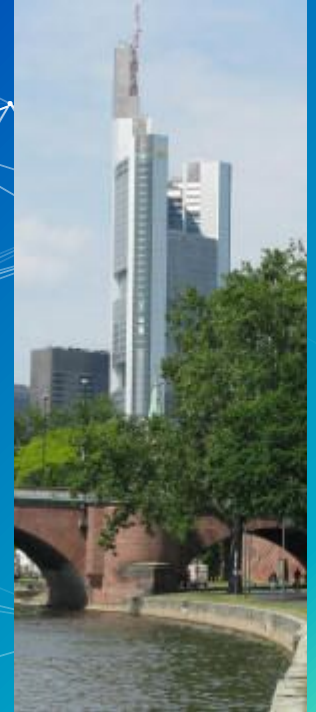
● Typical food

The Deutsche Bank Twin Towers. Completed in 1984 with reflective glass has 158 meter tall and the towers can change colour depending on weather conditions and on the angle of view.

The Kaiserdom. Located in the historic Old Town, the cathedral is also called Bartholomew's Cathedral.

The Old Opera House, is located on Opernplatz at the west. This original building was destroyed during World War II but has now been completely reconstructed.

The TV Tower is one of Frankfurt Germany's most recognizable landmarks. The Frankfurt Botanical Gardens are located in the green zone near the TV Tower.
