

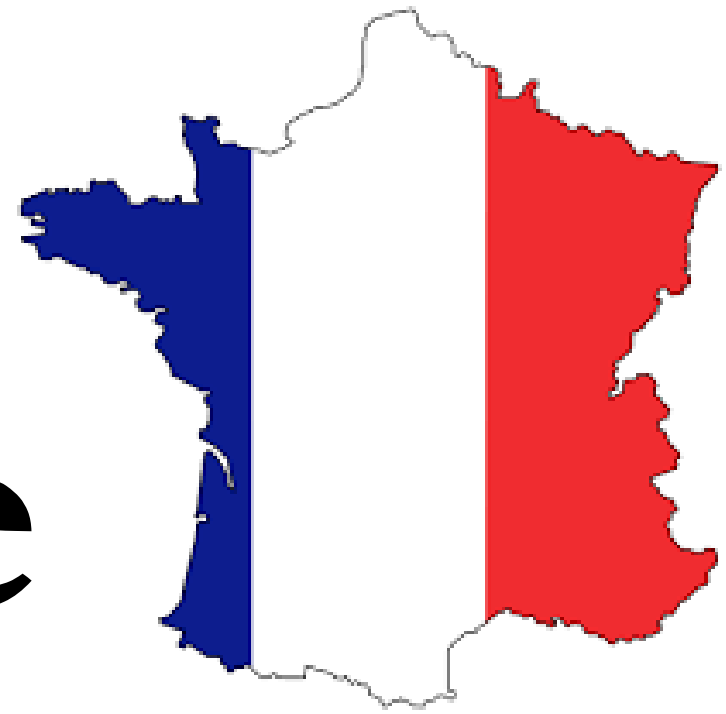

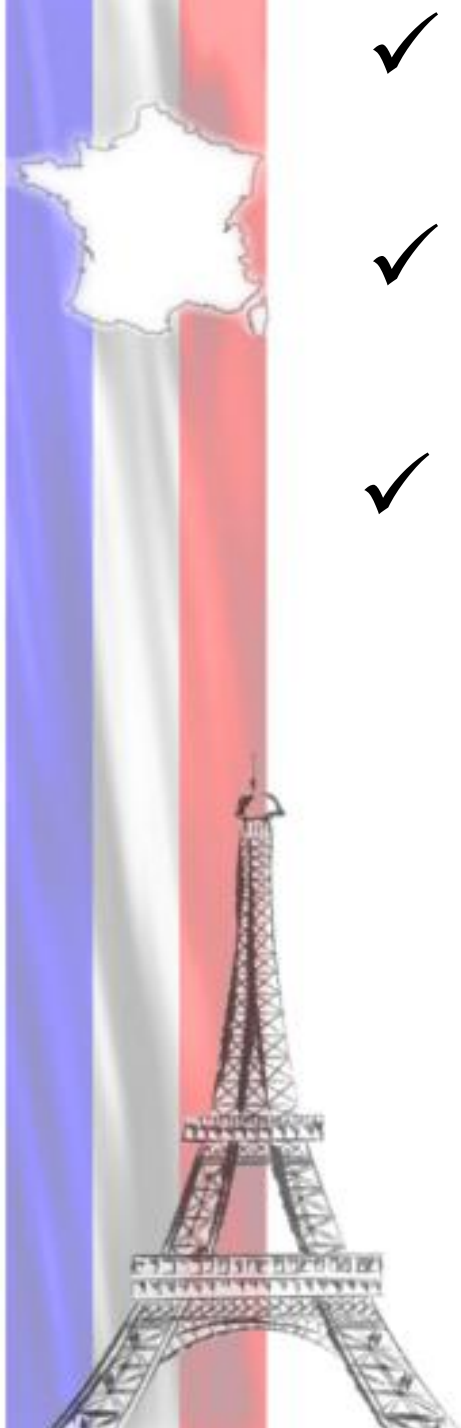

- ✓ The name France is derived from the Latin word 'Francia' meaning country of the Franks.

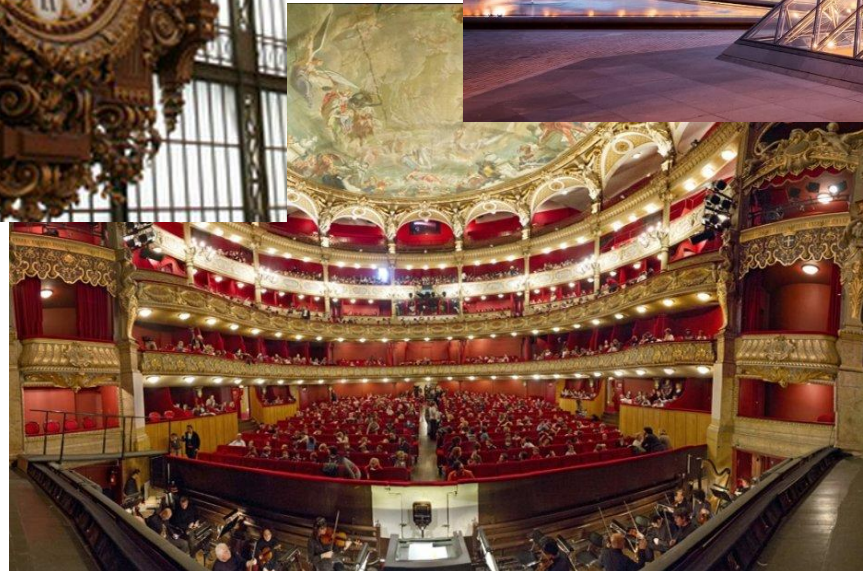


The capital, Paris, is one of the most beautiful cities in the world.

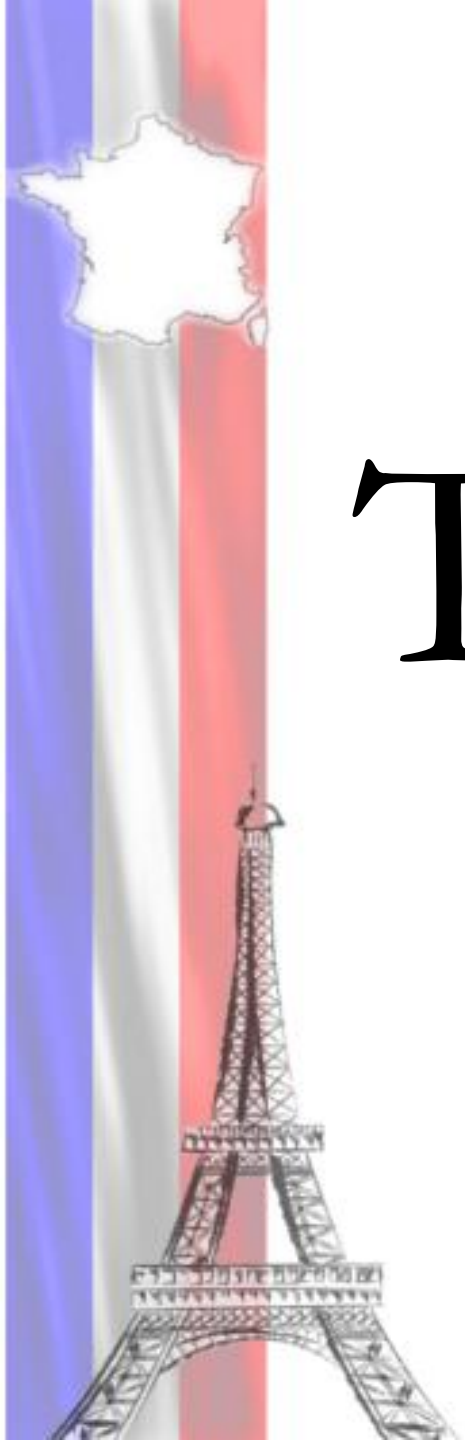

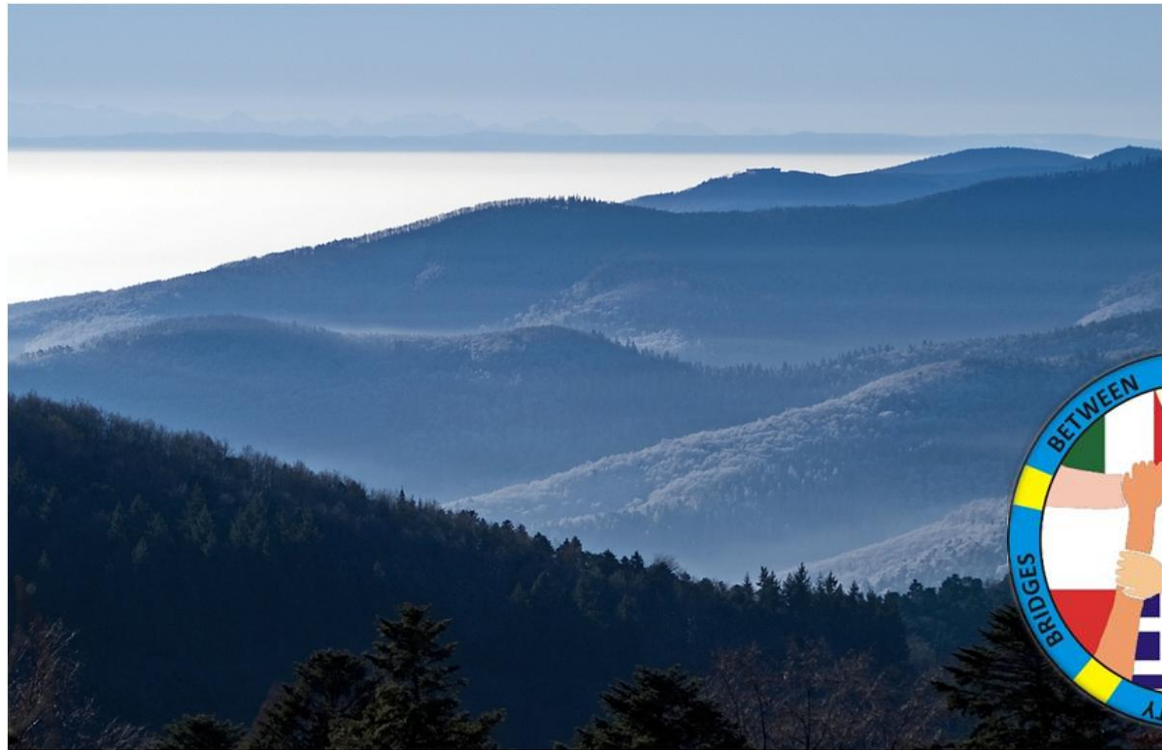


# The Vosges

woods...



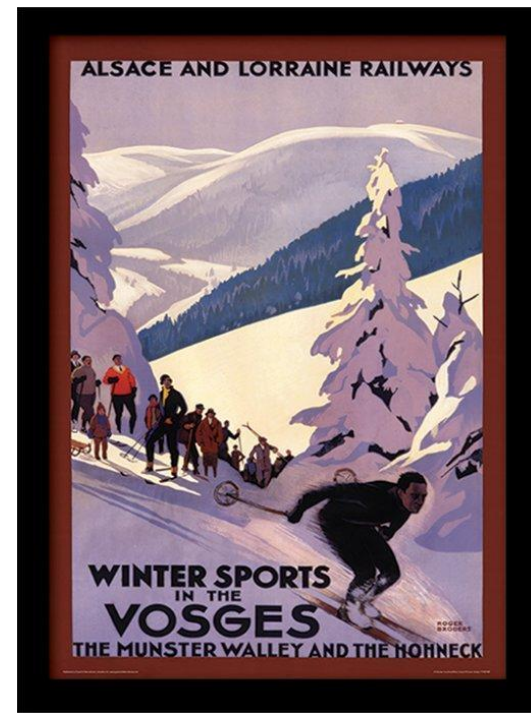


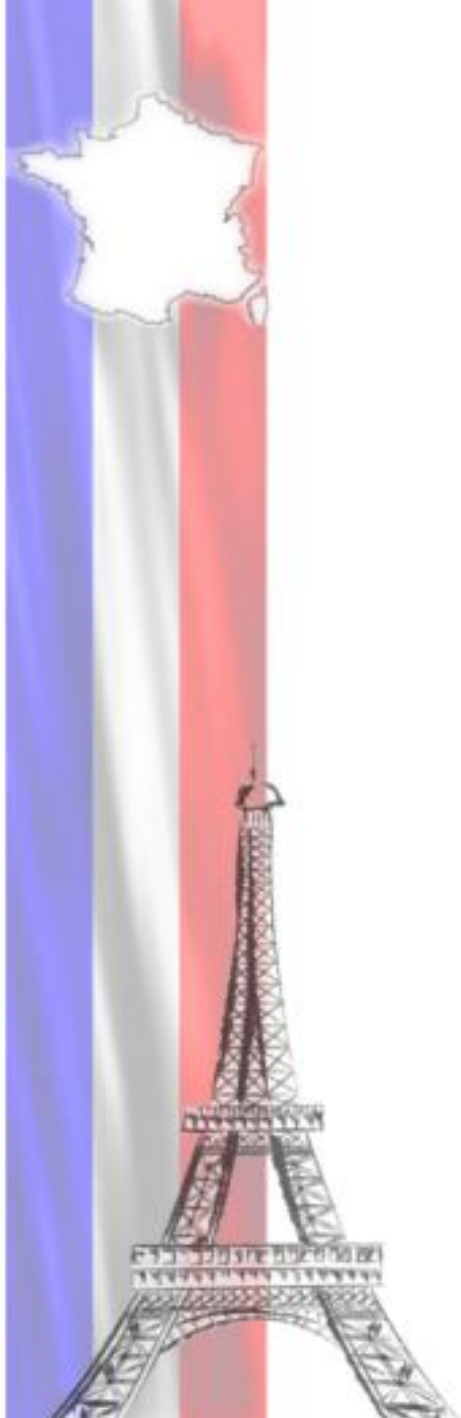
The climate is continental, with rather short summers and long snowy winters.

Gérardmer and La Bresse.



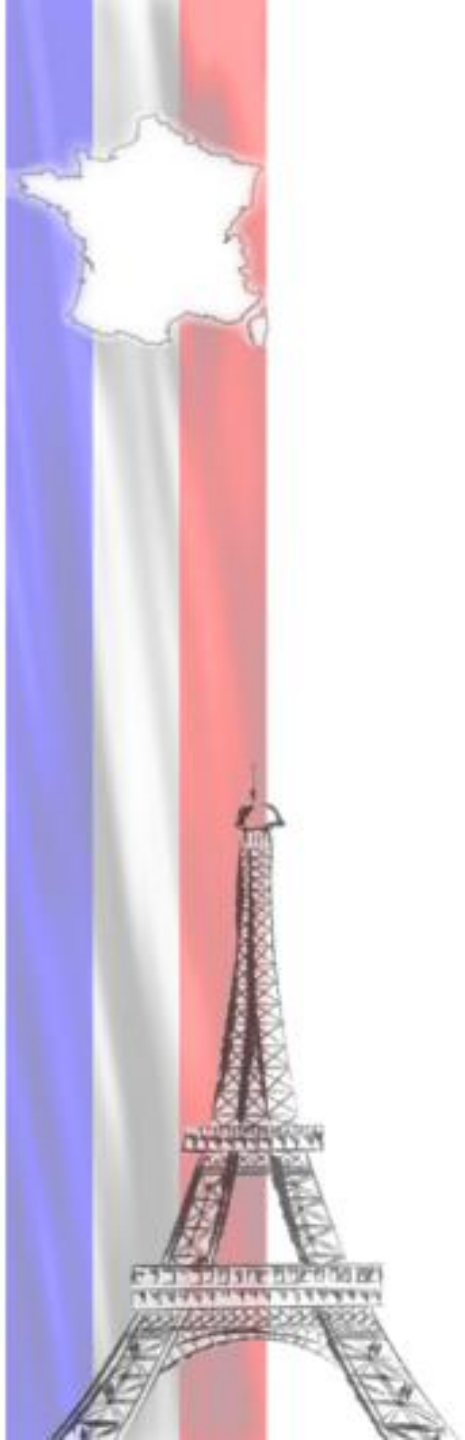


The Vosges are famous for its cheese,

The town has several parks and public gardens where locals and tourists can rest and contemplate the vegetation.



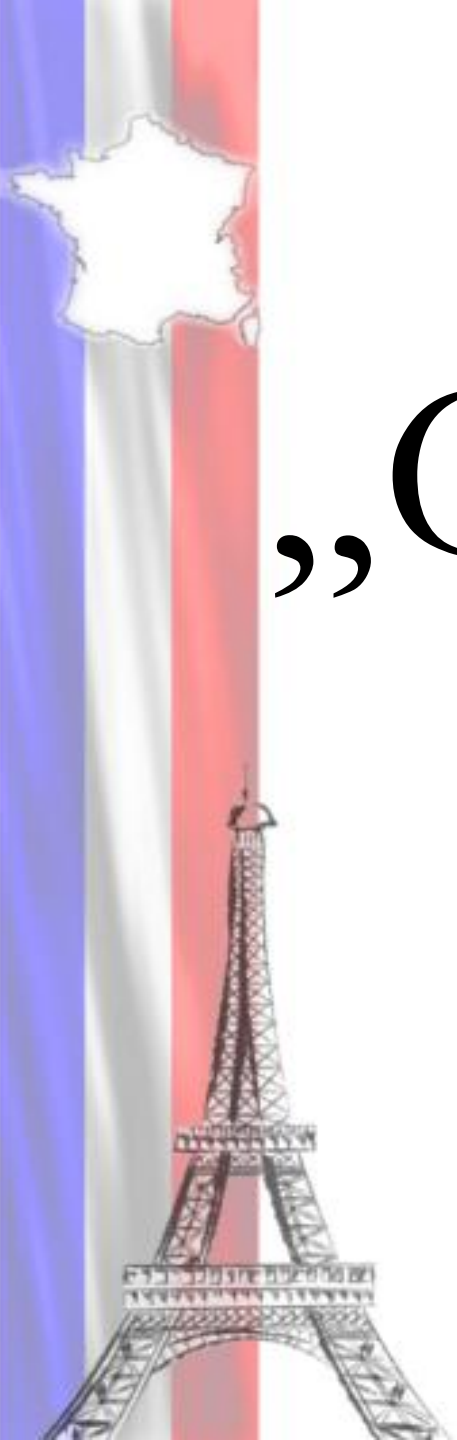
There is a variety of sports activities to engage in, for example cycling, kayaking, hockey...
