### Day 2: Tuesday 10 October 2017










## Day 3: Wednesday 11 October, 2017

That day was devoted to cultural activities. The participants visited the capital of Lithuania-Vilnius, situated on the banks of the river Neris and Vilnia. First time it was mentioned in 1323 when Grand Duke Gediminas built a castle there. Today the tower of the castle is one of the landmarks and symbols of the city. The Old town of Vilnius is one of the biggest and oldest in Eastern Europe. In 1994 Vilnius old town was included into Unesco heritage register. Both students and teachers had a chance to visit the Palace of Grand Dukes of Lithuania. Then all participants were enjoying the moments in Trakai castle-the one unique in the middle of the lake.

Trakai is a special region of Lithuania mostly influenced by previous nation called Karaims. Later all of us had lunch in a local restaurant tasting some special dishes characteristic for that region only.

The day started with a talk of the prof. Mr. R. Plunge clearly stating the progress of the students and aspects which have been improved in the process of film edition.

Then the participants filled the final questionnaires proving that they had learnt a lot during this Erasmus+ week in Lithuania. After the evaluation of the project activities and practices, the students and teachers were given the certificates of attendance.

In the afternoon the project participants were held the trip to the 9th Fort museum-a place of execution for Jews and captured Soviets.

## **Project meeting evaluation review**

The majority of participants had some expectations before coming to the project meeting; gaining film making knowledge, making cultural experience and making new friends. It was stated that the meeting objectives were clear and the most significant aspect was taken into account as all partners contribution to the success of the project meeting in an equal manner.96% of all participants claimed that the meeting met their expectations.

Everybody could mention some historical, geographical and cultural aspects of Lithuania. There were no extraordinary differences found concerning educational institutions(info about school) Except for better opportunities to improve English,3D room or strict uniform rules.

Some basic factors for film edition were presented as well; slow motion, close ups or different angles.

Greater part (80%) of all participants stated a

number of aspects and events to have an impact; beautiful friendship. hospitality, the punctuality of public transport, the history of Lithuania, the weather, the organization of cultural activities, the quality of workshops, trip to Vilnius and Trakai. As for the difficulties, language barrier among some students made face some communication gaps. Some students were complaining about food and fast life tempo.

Positive points; Organization, food, free time activities, knowledge of a specific field related to editing films, kindness of people, coordinating teachers, the infrastructure, high level of workshops in Vytautas Magnus university.

Areas of improvement; punctuality, useful links for students about film edition, cooperative work, transportation and Lithuanian weather.
