5. ACTIVITY DETAILS

Day 1: Monday, 12 March 2018

Objective: getting to know the partners, Romanian culture and history, presenting the host school, country, region.

The first day of the exchange was devoted to presenting the host institution, country, customs etc.. After welcoming speeches on the part of the headmaster and the project coordinator, we had the tour of our school, followed by some ice-breaking activities, for students.













Romanian students presented our school, its material basis, other extracurricular activities and











projects, but also its prizes and results which make us one of the best in our region.

During ice-breaking activities, students played some entertaining games conducted by some of our volunteer students. In the meantime, teachers had the opportunity to share their project experiences since the last meeting, the problems they had to deal with and the solutions they had found.

In the second half of the programme, we presented our country and its recent history, including some cultural, political and economic aspects, which connect us with other European countries. We presented the Romanian royal family, related to the British Monarchy, the descendants of the Habsburgs, and its role during the Balcanic Wars in the 19th century, the communist regime, present-day Romania, and some famous representatives of our country. Teams were also tested on their knowledge of Romania. We organized a competition between the guest teams and offered a prize to the winners. The prize consisted of a professional photo album offered by our partners, FNB Studio. It was fun and everybody learnt a lot about different aspects of the Romanian culture and history.

After the film and the quiz contest, we presented the agenda of the week and the trainers: Alina Simionescu, actress, and Cristian Florea, film specialist. We announced the topic of the film that students had to make – Europe Unites Us – and then split the participants into five multicultural teams, each one developing an idea in this direction. Every student had a certain position in the team: script writer, director, cameraman, actor etc. The main task was to make a short film about European values.





















Day 2: Tuesday, 13 March 2018

Objective: to present and discuss short films about gender discrimination in each country, analysing technical aspects of each film; cultural trip – visiting the Astronomic Observatory.

On the second day of LTTA4 participants watched short films tackling the issue of gender discrimination, made by all the teams from partner countries. The films were discussed by a professional in the film-making area and the other participants. Participants expressed their opinions on the quality of the films, underlining strengths and weaknesses of each piece, as well as similarities and differences.

After the film session, the professional ran a workshop about film-making. As some students were not familiar with the concepts, the professional delivered a round-up session with the participants about what film-making entails.





Because they were supposed to work as a team in order to create the film "Europe Unites Us", during the workshop students had to simulate a production team, each one with his/her duties: screen-writer, producer, cameraman, actors... They had the opportunity to see the requirements of each position in the team, to plan, to take best decisions for the film.

During the students' workshop, teachers had a project meeting, where they planned the future activities and the mobility from Turkey.

After the workshop, students and teachers visited the Astronomic Observatory.

















Day 3: Wednesday, 14 March 2018

Objective: learning about acting and film production; shooting the video.

The third day of the LTTA4 was entirely focused on film-making, the main theme of the project.

In the morning participants attended a workshop conducted by a professional actor, which was intended to make students learn how to perform in a film, tips and tricks about expressing different feelings, as well as other games meant to increase group cohesion.



















Students were assigned tasks to create a short film entitled Europe Unites Us. They all became actors in their own film, understanding that they have not only the same problems, but similar values; the film they created puts forward the message that youth and joy is what unites us all under the same umbrella of the European Union. The final product was a collage of different shots made by each team during the day. The film was edited with the aid of the film professional.



















Day 4: Thursday, 15 March 2018

Objective: promoting regional places of interest: cultural trip – visiting Bran and Peleş Castle.

On the fourth day, after a new editing workshop in which students finalized the film *Europe Unites Us*, participants went on a trip to Rucar-Bran-Sinaia, in order to catch a glimpse of the cultural and natural potential of our country. On our way, guests were able to admire the wild landscapes of the Carpathian Mountains, the Bran Castle, where they found out about Vlad Ţepeş, known as Count Dracula, and about the Romanian Royal Family. The main attraction was the Peles Castle, which was not only the Royal family's residence, but also a true masterpiece of art and architecture.





The evening ended with a festive dinner, where students and teachers spent time together, danced to traditional songs from all countries.











Day 5: Friday, 16 March 2018

Objective: evaluating the LTTA4; farewell.

In the last day we got back from the trip, taking one last stop in Braşov, one of the largest Romanian cities, important commercial centre during the Middle Ages.

Arriving at school, the final movie* was presented in front of other teams and a feedback was given on the same day. The positive aspects were highlighted, as well as the aspects that can be improved in future film projects. Participants were presented with certificates of attendance and Europass mobility forms were completed.







In the evening all the teachers took part in the Farewell Party dedicated to Women's Day. The participants enjoyed themselves a lot, not only dancing to pop music, but also having fun dancing traditional folk dances. The students had free time with the hosts.

6. Informal discussions

From the informal discussions, we realized that the learning activity had a great impact on participants, hosts and parents' hosts. They all got attached to the student they hosted and most of them expressed the intention to visit each other in the future as a result.

One of the most important gains from this experience is the interpersonal and intercultural exchange. Students were able to experience the customs, traditions and mentalities of other people in Europe which they found were not quite so dissimilar.

Another conclusion drawn from informal discussions was that everybody improved themselves to a certain extent — either linguistically, personally, interpersonally. Some host students declared becoming more open-minded and sociable. Besides that, students in our school became more cohesive, learned to work in teams, to solve problems. They improved their communication skills and organisational competences.

The fact that the week combined social activities organized by the hosts and professional workshops organized by the school representatives allowed each student to explore themselves in different contexts and to know themselves and the other better.

This experience brought people together in the unique way that only Erasmus+ can. All participants were grateful for being part of the Erasmus+ experience and declared being interested in getting involved in any other future experiences of this kind.
