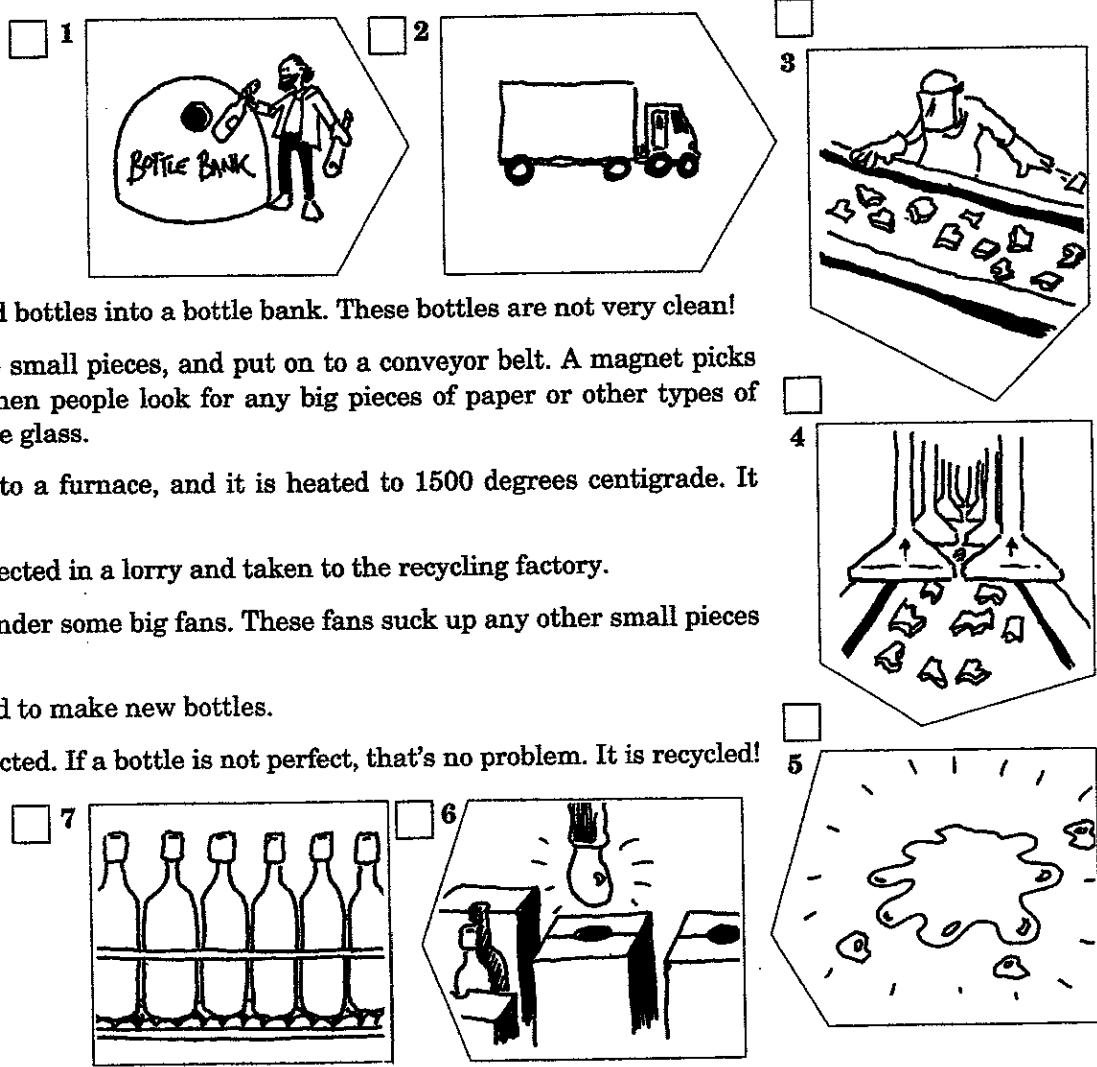


READ, THINK AND FIND.

What is this bottle made of? Glass, of course, but it isn't made of **new** glass. It's made from the glass from old bottles. This bottle was made in a glass recycling factory.

Do you know what happens? Look at the pictures. They are in the right order. They show you what happens. Then find the correct sentences to go with each picture. The sentences you need are below.



- A First people put their old bottles into a bottle bank. These bottles are not very clean!
- B The glass is broken into small pieces, and put on to a conveyor belt. A magnet picks up any pieces of iron, then people look for any big pieces of paper or other types of rubbish that are with the glass.
- C Now the glass is put into a furnace, and it is heated to 1500 degrees centigrade. It melts, of course!
- D Next the bottles are collected in a lorry and taken to the recycling factory.
- E Next, the glass moves under some big fans. These fans suck up any other small pieces of rubbish.
- F The melted glass is used to make new bottles.
- G All the bottles are inspected. If a bottle is not perfect, that's no problem. It is recycled!
