# PLAYERS:

# NAMES:

In Italy we can call it with different names :

# HISTORY:

We have 2 hypotheses about the background of the games :

- 1) Romans used to play this game in the ancient Rome and they call it " Gioco dello zoppo."
- 2) In ancient Egypt they played it too but , we don't have information about it .

# EQUIPEMENT:

To play you need some big chalks to draw on the floor and some stones .

# RULES

- 1) Use chalk to draw a hopscotch pattern on the ground
- 2) Create a diagram with ten sections and number them.
- 3) Each player has a marker such as a stone
- 4) The first player stands behind the starting line to toss his or her marker into square one.
- 5) All hopping is done on one foot unless the hopscotch design is such that two squares are side-by-side.
