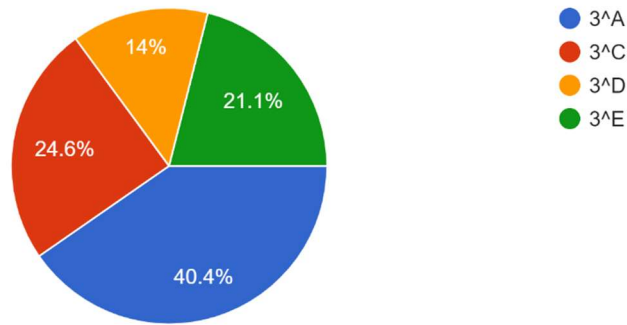

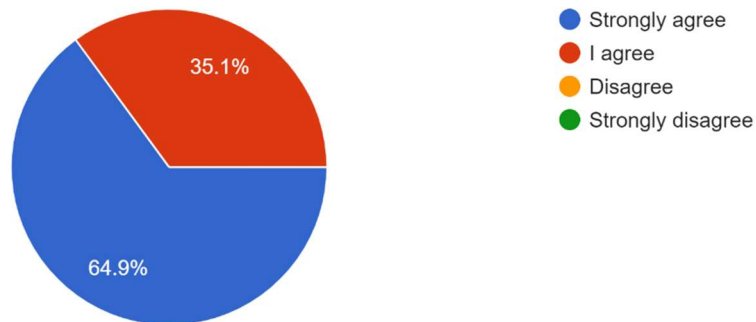
What is your son/daughter's class?

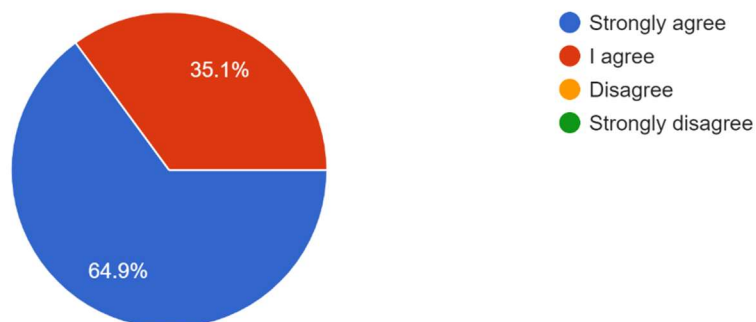
1. Studying foreign languages will help my child make a better progress in life.

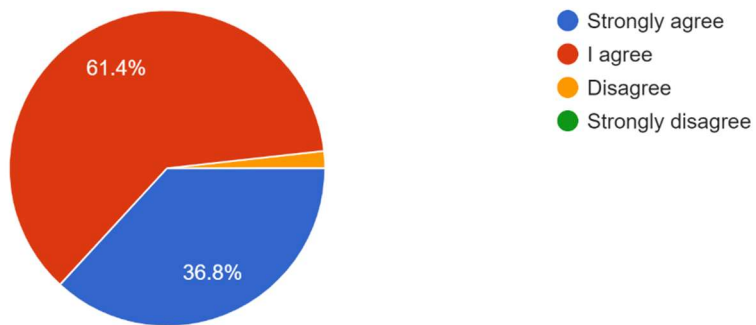
2. Foreign languages are easier to learn if they are taught from early childhood.

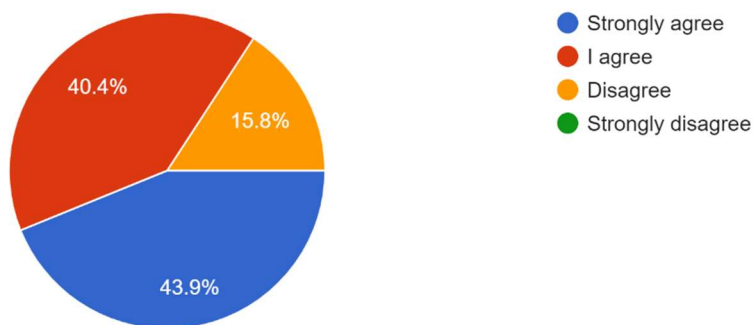

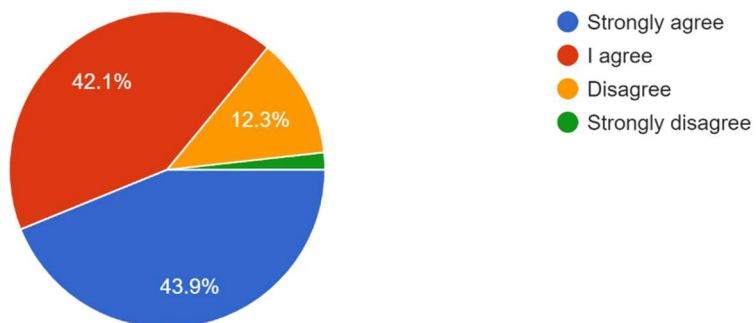
4. I would also like to have had the opportunity to study two foreign languages like students nowadays.

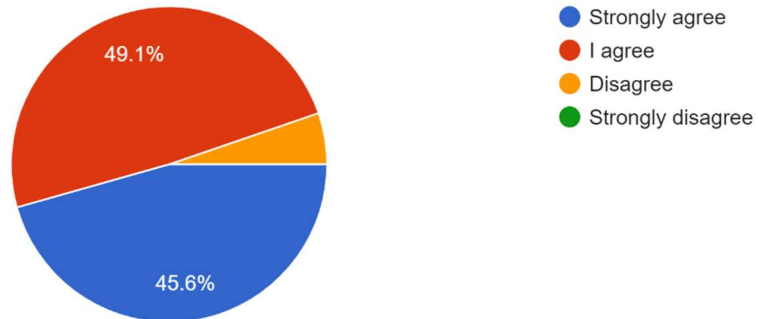

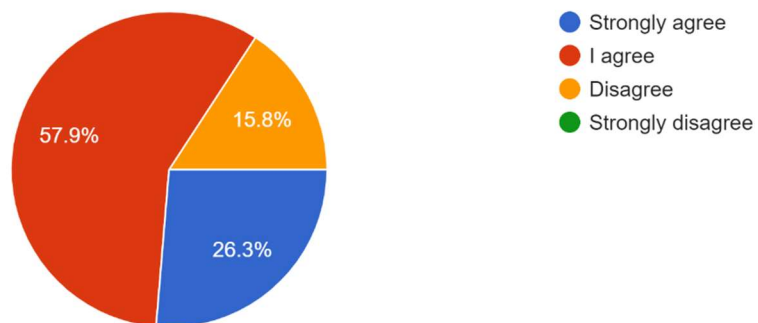

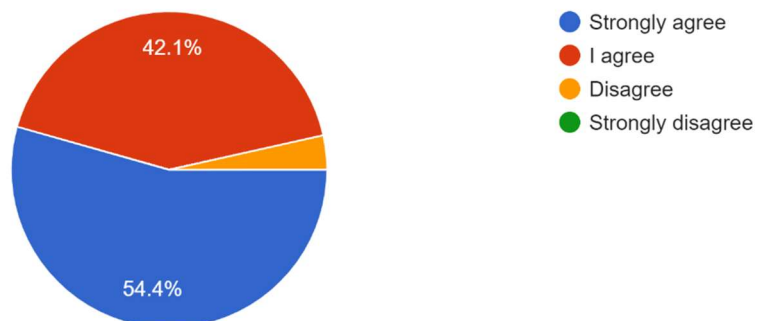

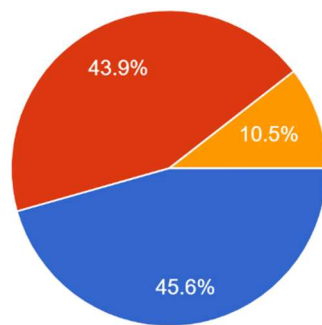

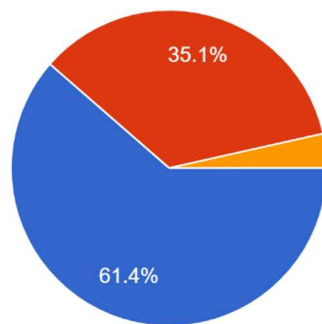
