The degations (Italy, Portugal, Ireland, France) have been welcome with shows and icebreaking activities:















We met Ivica Puljak, a nuclear physician from CERN, who held such a captivating lecture on the solar system and the mysteries of Universe.









Students have also taken part to arts workshops and didactic-scientific games, such like "Escape Room".









