








17.30 - Teachers Webinar "Innovative methods in working with students"























May 24 – Tuesday



The activity permitted every students to be creative and to work together with their classmates and peers from the partner schools.











Each school partner continued to work on their lapbook. The students studied about the Children's Dan and then they adjusted the lapbook templates or created other news in an originally way guided by the teachers.














During this workshop every school partner presented their lapbooks/products. It was a great opportunity to discover and to learn from each other information regarding the main topic Children's Day or childhood.












- The students also enjoyed having the opportunity to tell fellow students about their background and traditions.
- This activity was an easy way to have a practical activity in the classroom.
