This day was dedicated to the presentation of our Erasmus projects. One of the main projects we had the honor to participate in is definitely Achieve +. The student participants of the project were responsible for organizing a modest event with respect to the limitations. They prepared a few activities and some refreshment for the other students and teachers who wanted to come.

Despite the adversity of covid restrictions, students did a very good job in arranging, dividing and organizing three different workshop stages where the event took place. There was an **art exhibition** for older students, a presentation of our mobilities called **Erasmus Experience** and an ancient Greek **theatre play**. At the same time, the most interesting parts of the educational materials were introduced in a brief workshop seminar for teachers.

I. The theatre play

One group of the participating students were supposed to teach our youngest pupils a Greek theatre play. Before the Achieve Day started, the students had performed the play themselves for the younger audience and then they passed the tasks and screenplay. They had also instructed the younger students how to make appropriate costumes.

During the Achieve day it was possible to see two plays, Battle of Thermopylae and the legend of the founding of Athens. The students' performance was very convincing and professional.
