# DESCRIPTION

**The swan is one of the largest flying birds in the world , its size is 2.5 m. The ty pical weight of a swan is 11.3 to 15.88. From the tip of the beak to the end of its tail a swan mesure 1.5m. The sawn neck has 23 vertebrae, more than any other bird. The swans have white plumaje. They have gray plumaje when they are young.**
