







- Quick Response Code

- data for a locator, identifier, or tracker that points to a website or application















QR-CODES IN OUR LOCAL AREA

on the ticket machine: to get the app to buy your bus ticket online



In museums: to get more information about the topic



USING OF QR-CODES IN THE CULTURAL FIELD

- access in several languages
- efficient & small code marker
- use of different media, for example movies, music, text
- to give more information and refer to other entries
- to meet individual needs
- easy to handle with smartphones & tablets





PERSONALLY USAGE

- Get quick further information that hides behind the code
- Checking when the bus arrives
- Very fast method to get to a website (e.g. on bills)
- Organizing a paperchase for other people with secret advices where to go next and giving the participants tasks to do
- Getting access to free WIFI in public
- Sporty Geocaching
- Easy rent bikes & scooters (eg https://www.li.me/how-to-lime...)
