Basic informations

- Škofijska gimnazija Vipava is a Catholic grammar school. Our principal is Vladimir Anžel.
- It has about 300 students between 15 and 19 years of age who have successfully finished elementary school and who intend to continue their study at the University.
- It is located in a small town Vipava in Vipava valley. Close to the school there is also a students dormitory.



The beginning

- The first beginnings date back to the 1950s when the Little Slovenian seminary was established.
- The new Catholic grammar school began in 1991 when it also became public school.

Program

- The educational programme lasts 4 years and finishes with Matura exams (General grammar school leaving external examination).
- Besides general subjects we have two special subjects: Latin, Religion and Culture.
- School offers different extra-curricular activities which are voluntary social work, journalistic activity, very good choir and others.



- Activities between classes are sports competitions, setting up cribs, Miklavževanje,...(this is a charity event. It is special event, because students can make fun from professors:)).
- We also have one weekend in a year on which we connect even more as a class.
