At school, in order not to create a crowd, classes on the ground floor enter ...



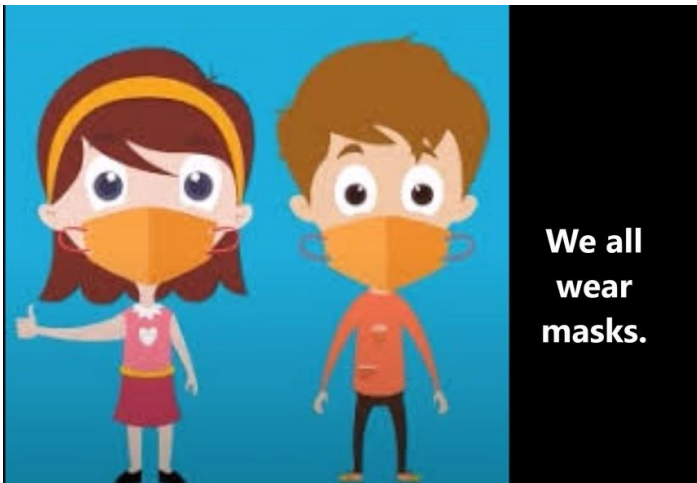
... through a secondary door.

... the right distance.

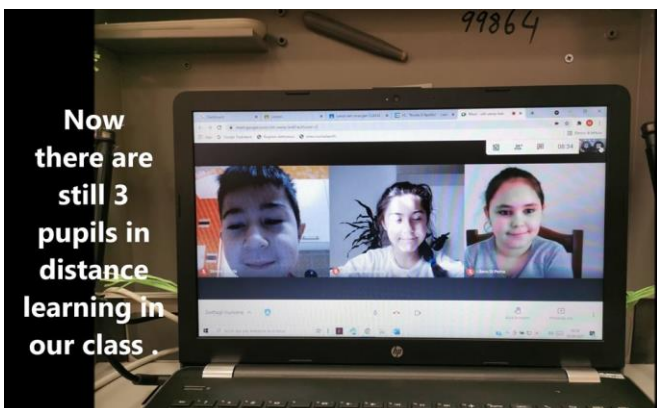


And now, we finally have a snack!

Now there are still 3 pupils in distance learning in our class.



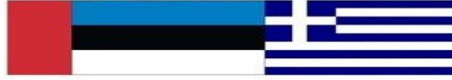
Covid-19 cause, we can't go to the gym.
