

On-line polls with **Poll Everywhere**



Poll Everywhere enables the user to create online polls and get instant answers. This enables live audience participation

We can use the poll everywhere to get direct feedback from our students during the lesson, check immediately if they are focused on the lesson and understand the content of the lesson or send the link to the parents to get their opinion on various issues, e.g. for what is the main day for an event.



Join Poll Everywhere as teachers

To use the Poll Everywhere service, we need to register. We will choose to sign up by stating that we will use it in training (K12) so we have more features than simple users (eg maximum number of replies per poll: 40)

Go to <https://www.polleverywhere.com/> and select from the top **Pricing** tab
On the next page, select the **K12** class and then **SignUp** in the free version **K12-Basic**

Fill in your details by leaving Europe the choice. The phone is not mandatory.



A confirmation / activation email will be sent to you. To activate the account you need to open the email and click on the link mentioned. Then sign in to your site with your account.


Create a simple poll

Sign in to Poll Everywhere and go to Poll. Click the Create button to create a new Poll

For our first poll, we select the type of Emotional Scale that can be used to start a lesson. Type the question in the appropriate field and press the CREATE button at the bottom of the page.



On the right panel, we find the arrangements for how our audience will participate in this poll. We will set this poll to ensure that participants are anonymous, able to respond many times and be able to change their response. So do the following:



in Visual Settings, we can change the appearance of the slide. You can experiment with the various options. Interesting is the option to hide instructions to the public about how they can respond and selecting the overall answers. For this example, we want to hide the instructions and display the number of answers:

Finally we hit SAVE To start receiving poll responses, enable Activate and also make sure Show Results is enabled. Once you've enabled the poll, anyone who has the link can log in and respond. The link is fixed for each user and consists of the text: PollEv.com/ followed by the user ID shown at the top right of the page. B.C.

Embedding a poll in a presentation

Poll Everywhere lets you integrate a poll in a presentation using either Microsoft PowerPoint or Google Slides. In Google Slides, you can either create a new presentation from the beginning or upload an existing presentation that you created with another program (such as Microsoft PowerPoint or Libre Office).

In order for integration to work, you must use the Google Chrome browser and install the add-on.

Open Google Chrome and sign in to the Poll Everywhere site. Go to your polls page.

Tap the Google Slides link to the left of the page


Click Add to install the Poll Everywhere for Google Slides plugin in your browser and confirm

Now we are creating a Multiple Choice poll

We go to <https://drive.google.com> and sign into our Google Account. We raise a ready presentation with the drag n 'drop method. Open the slideshow on Google Slides

Connect Google Slides - Poll EveryWhere


First, you'll need to link Google Slides to your Poll Everywhere account. From the menu, select **Poll EveryWhere -> Log In** and enter the link information for Poll



Import poll

Select the slide after which you want the poll to be entered.

From the Poll EveryWhere menu, select **Insert -> Activity** and select the poll you want to enter



You import the poll as a frame and you can move it or resize it. Delete the text boxes behind the poll so that it is alone on the slide


To see how your slide will appear to your viewers, press the **Present** button on the top right.

The page will open in full screen. To return to the slideshow view, press the ESC key

If you want to stay in slide show mode but not full screen, click on the tool at the bottom left of the screen (shown when you move the mouse to the right)

The page will open in full screen. To return to the slideshow view, press the ESC key

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Only one (1) poll can be active every time.

An interesting feature of Poll Everywhere is to include a poll on a Web Site. You can use this feature on your blog or on the eclass platform you use (eg Edmodo, class, Google Classroom, etc.) and allow your students to participate in a poll (eg for the previous lesson) or simply to show the results of a poll.

To find the embedding code of a post, click Share on a poll

Select **More Sharing Options** and then **Embed Poll**

The page that opens the first code is used to give you the ability to answer, while the second code is used to presentation of the results

Download and Install Poll Everywhere from Google Play

Open Google Play from your device and search for Poll Everywhere
