Romania: general situation is getting better, testing at school is time-consuming, students are still joining our project

Serbia: similar situation as in Romania, students only at school every second week

<u>Austria:</u> lockdown until 3 December, 90% are vaccinated, also testing at school, 5 students left the project, 19 students still there

<u>Portugal</u>: schools are open, more than 80% are vaccinated, some students left the project

<u>Greece:</u> schools are open, many new students are joining the project

<u>Germay:</u> schools are open, infection rates are high, only about 70% are vaccinated, still 15 students there, travel ban for students and teachers announced by local government (until Easter 2022),

therefore no mobility to Greece in March possible!

Mobilities: instead of going to Romania there will be a mobility to Greece in May (?), exact dates have to be agreed on asap, and a mobility to Germany in June, all German students will go to Greece and stay in hotels and all Greek students will go to Germany, as there is only one mobility for them, the others have two, so please devide your students into two groups
