Who we are and what we do!

- We are a Private Medical Emergency Service from Romania which intervenes in emergency medical cases and natural disasters.
 - TransMed is a (SRL) limited liability company.



Field of activity

- Main activity domain: pre-hospital emergency services and intervention in case of natural disasters
- Secondary activity domain: elderly care at home and organizing first aid points at events



Competitors

• There is only one company in our town that accomplishes pre-hospital medical intervention and there is not any company in case of natural disaster intervention.





Providers

• TransMed adheres to the legal provisions regarding the ambulances, the main supplier being DeltaMed (it is a private provider).





Equipment

• The equipment is of the highest quality, ranging from disposable utensils and medicine to ambulance equipm







Potential clients

• The potential clients of our company are represented by the population of Vâlcea county and the neighboring cities (in case of natural disasters). Our company, just like the public emergency services (Ambulance Service and SMURD), intervenes in medical cases that are assigned to us through the *Single National Emergency Notification Service* (SNEU) - the unique 112 number.



What we want to purchase!

• Our company wants to buy an ambulance, type B1 / B2. Its price is about 20,000 euros with all the equipment.











- Firstly, this ambulance is B1 / B2 type, requiring a smaller crew (EMT and nurse). It is not as competitive as C1/C2, but when the interventions are smaller and not lifethreatening, the costs can be considerably lower.
- For example, the use of a C1 / C2 ambulance amounts to 300 EUR while for the B1 / B2 ambulance is 200 EUR.



Why do we need a new ambulance.

• Secondly, the time of intervention for collective or multiple casualties decreases. It is the same for for natural disasters.



Our Start Up

• At present, the company owns a single C1 / C2 ambulance (advanced medical crew - doctor, nurse and EMT)
