

THE GREEK PARLIAMENT

The **Greek Parliament** is located in the Old Royal Palace, overlooking Syntagma Square in Athens. The history of the impressive building of the Greek Parliament is linked to the history of the Modern Greek state. It was designed by the Bavarian architect Friedrich von Gärtner and constructed from 1836 to 1843. Originally it served as a palace for the Greek monarchs for about a century but in 1934 it became the Parliament and Senate building and still houses the Greek Parliament today.
