



How to create multiple choice questions:

Check the following questions to find out if your questions and your possible answers are suitable for our quiz:

Content		
	Yes	No
Is the question really relevant for the test?		
Is the level/difficulty of the question suitable (not too easy, not too special, and not too trivial)?		
Is the content of the question technically controversial?		
Has the question been reviewed on relevance, comprehensibility and difficulty by a peer?		

Core of the question		
	Yes	No
Is the case appropriate?		
Is the language used clear and simple? Is the structure of the sentences easy to understand and not ambiguous?		
Are the abbreviations, terminology and foreign words used conventional and common?		
Has the text been substituted by pictures/ graphs as far as possible?		

Question		
	Yes	No
Clear structure?		
Is it about knowledge?		
Is the content of the question in accordance with the latest state of research?		
Can the question be answered without having read the possible answers?		
Were negations avoided?		
Is it a catch-22 question?		

Answer options		
	Yes	No
Is there one single correct answer?		
Are all distractors plausible?		
Are all answers of similar length, grammar and formal structure?		
Are the answers short (or can be parts of them transferred into the question)?		
Are there any double negations?		
Did you avoid „ <i>All above answers are true</i> “ as a possible answer?		
Did you avoid word repetitions of the core?		
Did you distribute the correct solutions equally on all answer options A, B, C and D?
