I. **DOCUMENTS.** PLEASE CHECK ALL YOUR DOCUMENTS ARE UPDATED.

II. DEPARTURE

> TRANSFERS

- WE HAVE TRANSFERS (BUS) FROM FUENTE PALMERA TO MALAGA AIRPORT. RETURN TICKET, SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT ASKING YOUR PARENTS TO DRIVE YOU.
- WE WILL LEAVE FUENTE PALMERA AT 6:00 AM ON SATURDAY 2ND DECEMBER.
- WE ALSO HAVE A BUS TRANSFER FORM WROCLAW AIRPORT TO KLUCZBORK, RETURN TICKET.

> FLIGHT

- I HAVE ALREADY BOUGHT YOUR FLIGHTS. PLEASE REMEMBER YOU HAVE TO GIVE ME BACK YOUR BOARDING PASSES AFTER USING THEM, WE CANNOT LOOSE THEM. I NEED THEM TO PROVE OUR PARTICIPATION IN THE ERASMUS PROJECT.
- WE LEAVE ON SATURDAY 2ND DECEMBER FROM MALAGA AIRPORT AT 11.30 AND WE RETURN ON SATURDAY 9TH DECEMBER AT 11:00 TO MALAGA AIRPORT.

III. YOUR LUGGAGE

- We have paid for a CHECKED LUGGAGE UP TO 20 KILOGRAMMES. THESE ARE THE MEASUREMENTS.
- Additionally you are allowed to carry with you a SCHOOL BAG, measurements 35x20x20 (GIRLS - YOU CANNOT WEAR A PURSE OR HANDBAG, OK? ONLY THE SCHOOLBAG, REMEMBER, NOT BOTH)
- If you wish you can also bring a suitcase up to 10 kilogrammes, but this one will also go as CHECKED LUGGAGE, THAT IS, IT WILL NOT GO WITH YOU ON THE PLANE!!!
- PLEASE USE LOCKERS TO ZIP YOUR LUGGAGE. AND DON'T LOOSE THE KEY!!!
- PLEASE, REMEMBER THAT SCISSORS, AND SHARP OBJECTS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE PLANE, ONLY IN THE CHECKED LUGGAGE.
- IF YOU HAVE LIQUIDS THEY HAVE TO FULFIL THE REQUIREMENTS OF QUANTITY (UP TO 50 ml each bottle, and UP TO 1 LITRE TOTAL) AND THEY HAVE TO BE PACKED IN AN OFFICIAL PLASTIC BAG.
- BOTH LIQUIDS AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES SHOULD GO IN YOUR HAND LUGGAGE AND HAVE TO BE READY FOR EASY ACCESS.
- REMEMBER THAT DEODORANT DOESN'T USUALLY FULFIL THESE REQUIREMENTS.

 ASK YOUR HOST IF YOU NEED TO BRING A HAIRDRYER, I DON'T THINK YOU HAVE TO. BUT BETTER ASK. HAIR STRAIGHTENERS AND HAIRDRYERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE HAND LUGGAGE. IF I WERE YOU I WOULD PUT IT IN THE SCHOOLBAG.
