Mooswiese

- A public festival in Feuchtwangen
- During September
- Famous festival in Franconia
- Many fun rides



Oktoberfestival

- Most famous festival in Bavaria
- Startet in 2006
- Every year from September to Oktober
- 6.2 million visitors
- 469 open barrels

→ Traditional Outfit in Bavaria



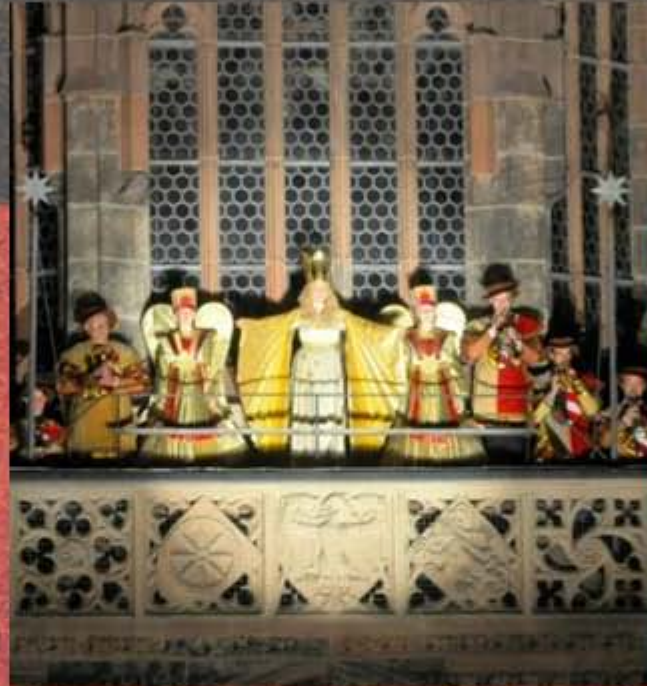
Easter
