Lesson Plan Rhauderfehn

Topic/ Title of Project: America first? – Europe second!

Lesson goals / learning outcomes:

- Students enhance their intercultural competences while working in an international group.
- Students prepare a booklet titled "Europe second" based on the idea
 of an online hit called "Ostfriesland second" to present the benefits of
 all the regions they live in.
- Students improve their language skills by describing their region, comparing it to other regions, by discussing their ideas and finding a compromise with their group members and by presenting their idea in front of the other groups.
- Students develop their skills in working with modern technology, i.e. up- and downloading images in TwinSpace and using the applet "Bookcreator".

Homework: Prepare a list with the top 10 of your regions. Think of food, culture, language, buildings, people, animals, sports, freetime activities... Take pictures of them and upload them to the TwinSpace beforehand.
