



Minutes of the Transnational Teacher Meeting at Hemne videregående skole, Norway

1. Dates for travelling

- a. The first two Short-term Exchanges of Groups of Pupils dates were discussed and decided upon:
 - i. Ireland: March 12th to March 20th, 2019.
 - ii. France: September 17th to September 25th, 2019.
 - iii. Dates for Norway are probably the second week in February 2020.

2. Program Content

- a. eTwinning website is up and going and Ireland is responsible for the upkeep of it.
- b. Visit to Ireland in March 2019
 - i. Theme = Cultural Heritage and Community. Ronan will send details about students' activities a month or so before the visit. Communication will be maintained through our eTwinning Twinspace and email.
- c. Visit to France in September 2019
 - i. The French teachers (Anne-Louise Carnec and Corinne Le Doaré) will send details about the theme and activities in the month of June so that students are prepared for the September visit.

3. Job Shadowing for Teachers

- a. All the countries are interested. There will be one teacher sent from each country to each of the partner countries within the duration of the project. Individual dates will be set up by the cooperating schools. Greece is planning to send a German teacher to Norway in March 2019. An application form will be put up on the eTwinning website, available to all countries.

4. Long-term Mobilities for Students

- a. This is where the majority of funding is to be found in the project. Ireland, France and Norway have applied for 10-month individual mobilities; Greece has 2 months. Each country will make a special effort to disseminate this information and to encourage their students to apply. An application form will be put up on the eTwinning website, available to all countries.
