

- was established in Heraklion, Crete, Greece in 2005.
- Is a public school and operates under the authority
 - of Regional Director of Primary and Secondary Education of Crete
 - of National Ministry of Education.
- Is an Accredited European School
 - Its part of the network of the European schools and operates according to the General Rules of the European Schools
 - it was established primarily to provide schooling for children of the staff of the European Network and Information Security Agency (ENISA).









Setting

Education Heraklion (SEEH)

- Total surface 1500m²
- Main building 2000m² arranged in four floors
- Auditorium 170m²
- Yard 750m²

















 The European School system consists of two years of early education (nursery cycle), five years of primary and seven years of secondary education.

Cycle	Classes	Age
'Early education' (Nursery)	1-2	4 and 5
Primary	1-5	6-10
Secondary Observation cycle Pre-orientation cycle Orientation cycle	1-3 4-5 6-7	11-13 14-15 16-18





- There are two language sections:
 - Greek, English
- All the syllabuses followed in the different sections are identical and lead up to the same examination: the <u>European Baccalaureate</u> (different from the International Baccalaureate, IB)
 - 2015- First Baccalaureate Exams for Greek section
 - 2016- First Baccalaureate Exams for English section
 - 2017- Nine students took Baccalaureate Exams from both sections





- Total number of teachers 50
 - Nursery 3, Primary 10, Secondary 37
 - Unfortunately no administration staff!
- Total number of pupils 258
 - Nursery 26, Primary 124, Secondary 108
 - 4% of student population are Category 1 pupils (ENISA and European Commission)


