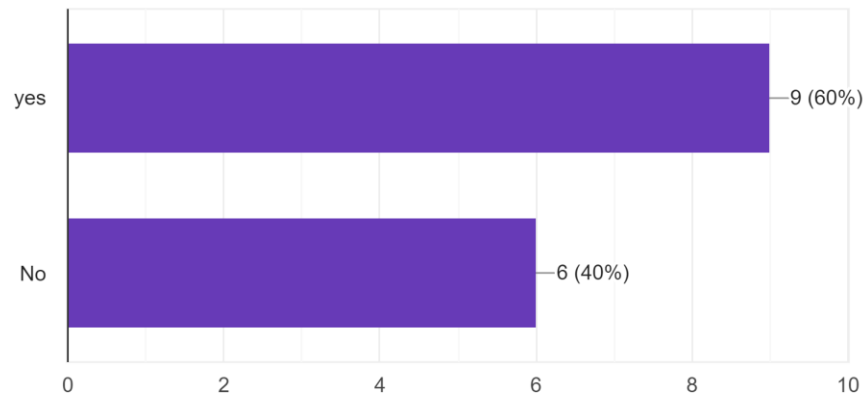


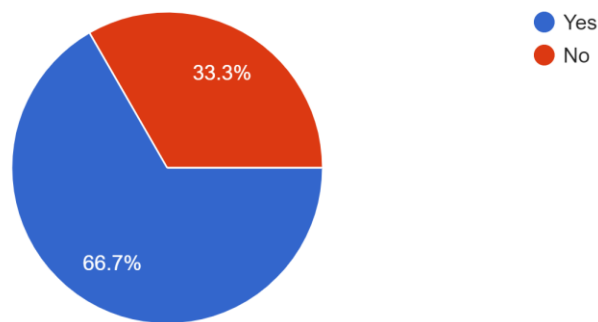
## Is this the first project you have been involved with?

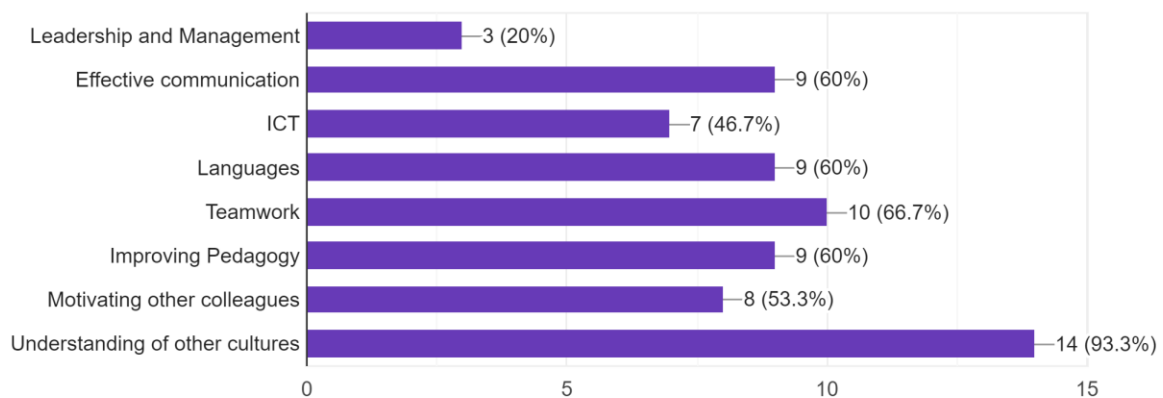
## Did you take part in any of the mobilities?
