After that each school had to organize an in-school voting in order to pick the best 3 logos for the school (country). As a result we had a collection of 15 logos for the big final.

In February 2019, when all schools were in Greece for the first meeting, the online voting started.

All the logos were given names and they were visible not only in E-twinning but also on the voting platform [Surveyhero.com](https://surveyhero.com/).

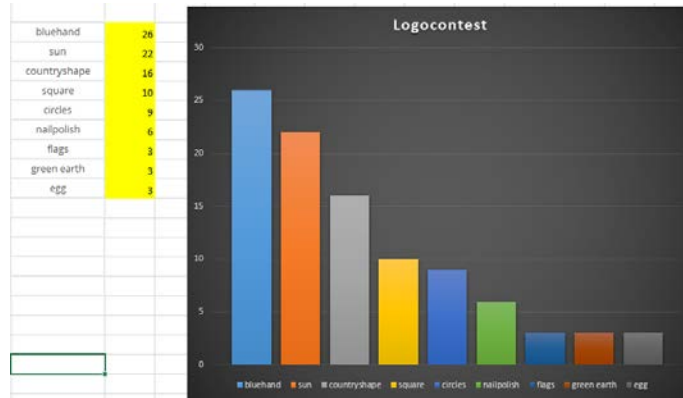
All the schools received their own QR-code that made it possible for the students and the teachers to vote.

A separate ranking was made for every country.
