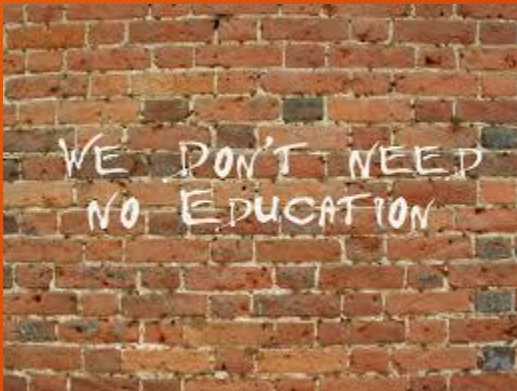
What jobs are lacking workers?

- There are over 100 jobs in the Netherlands that are lacking, among them are: medical personnel, teachers, farmers, public transport workers and many more.



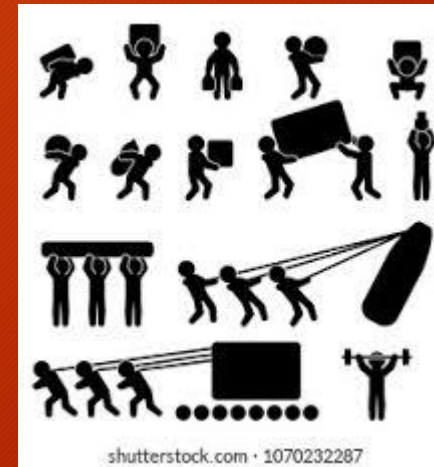
What skills are needed?

- Granted the migrant doesn't speak Dutch, they won't have a lot of opportunities, mainly physical labour with a low need of education or experience.



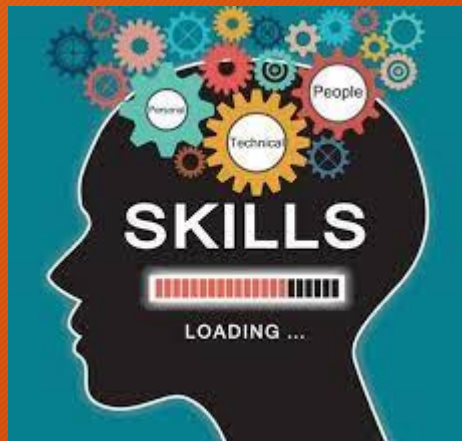
Any chances for education/training for immigrants to improve their job status?
