- Population 99 274 inhab.

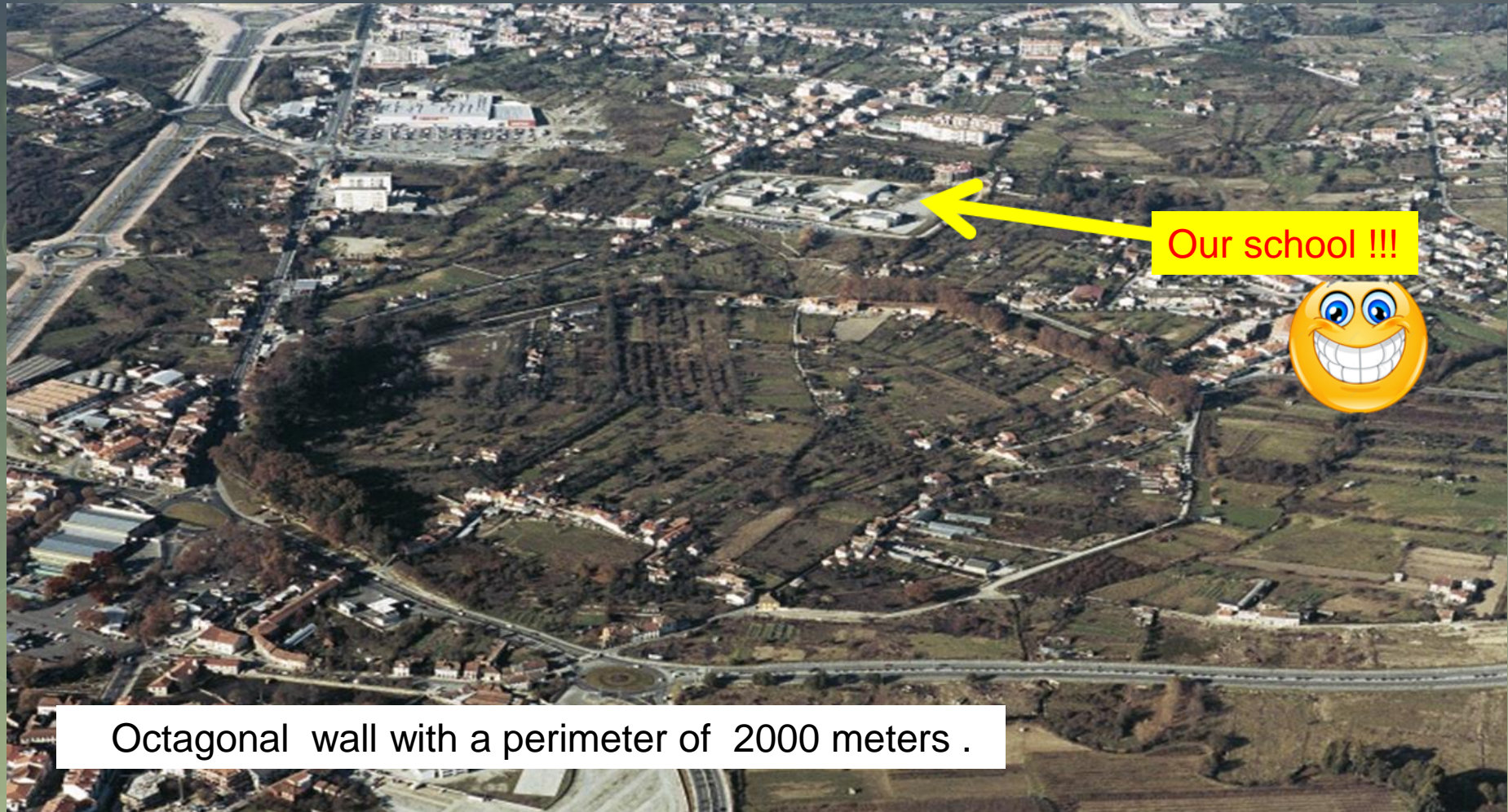


Viseu is associated with the figure of Viriato, because it is said that this Lusitan hero was born in this region.

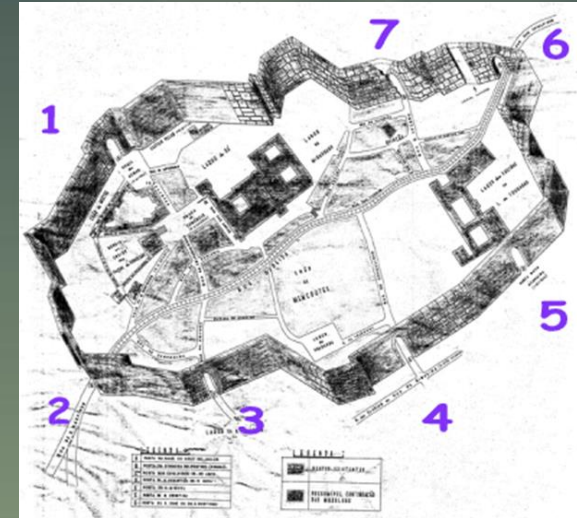

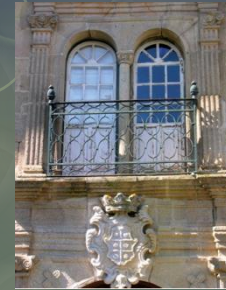
