


CARICA <u>GAME</u>

What does it take to play it? - At least 2 players; - Each player has his/her own carica (he must have some brand to know it's his own);

-A place to create the route. The route is drawn on the ground. Game description: -After the route is drawn on the ground, each player puts his carica on the starting line.

-One at a time, with your finger, pushing your carica forward.

-If the carica leaves the route has to return to the beginning or to the last place before that exit.

-Beat the player who gets to the finish line first.
