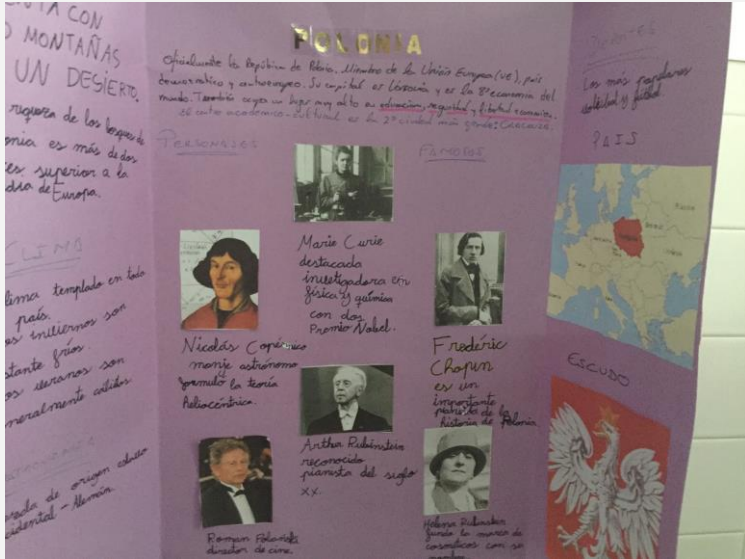

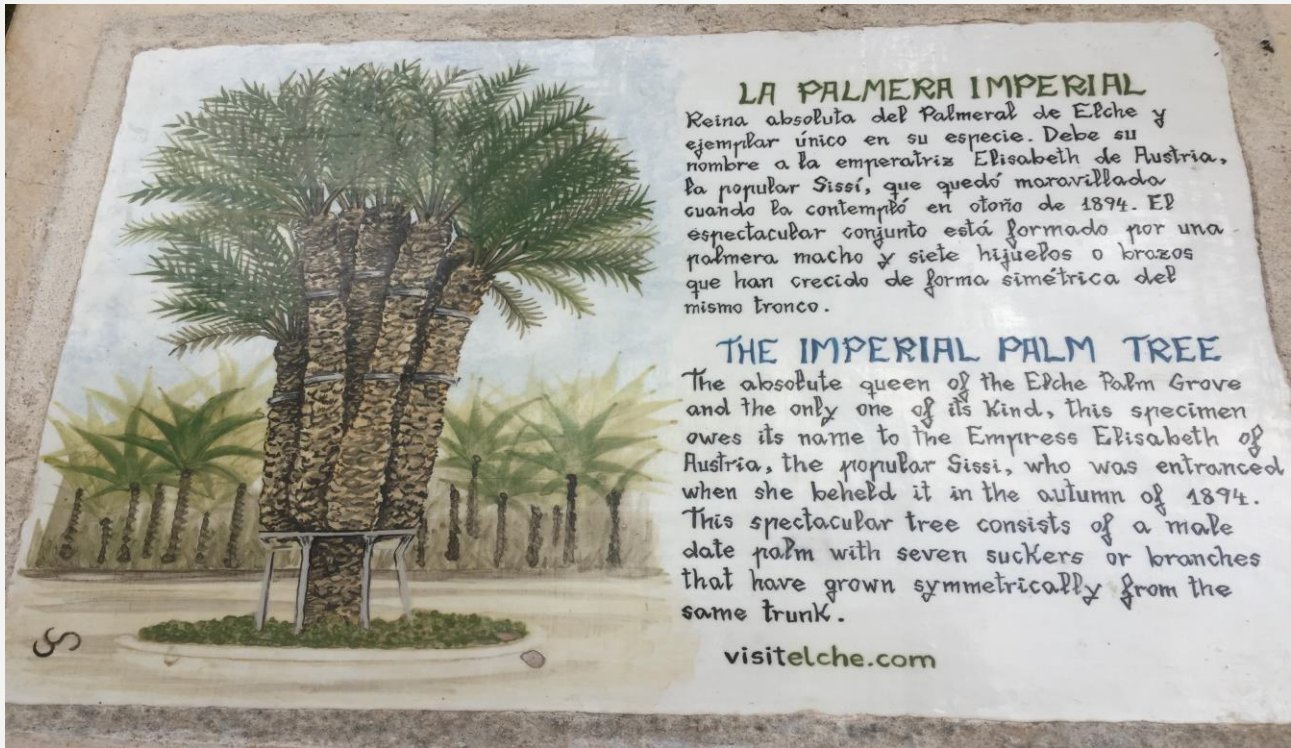
WEDNESDAY, MAY 29TH

The Palm Grove Huerta del Cura, is the largest grove in Europe with around half a million trees. It is believed, that it was the Carthaginians who established the grove. The oldest one is over 300 years and it's named after the Austro-Hungarian empress, Sisi, who paid a visit to Elche in 1894. UNESCO site.

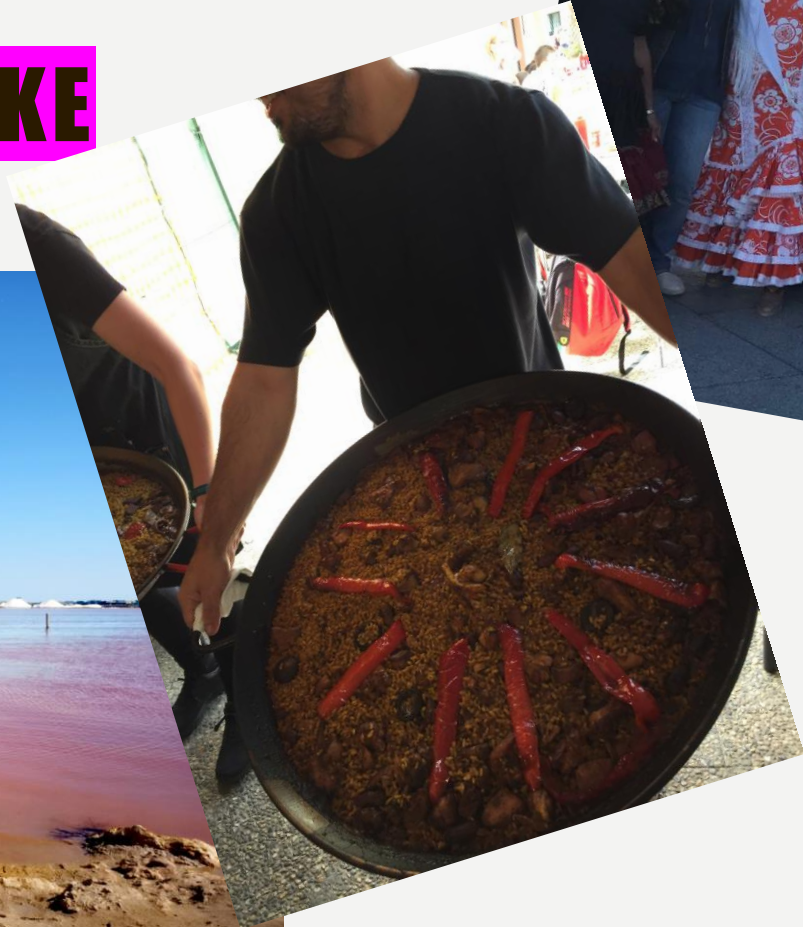
